Sewer and Waster Water Treatment Facility Reminder

Please be aware that everything that goes down your drain comes out at the Waste Water Treatment Facility. Many of these items cause damage to the treatment plant and prevent the process from working the way it should. In addition to costly expenses associated with fixing the system, foreign substances cause misreads on our required testing, which can lead to violations and fines.

“Flushable” wipes do not break down. Neither do Q-tips, diapers, pills, paper towels, feminine products, grease, fats and oils.

Nothing should go down the drains except human waste and toilet paper.

The required treatment plant upgrades has been a massive undertaking over the years. We all need to do our best to preserve our investment. If you ever have any questions, please call Town Hall during regular hours and we will be happy too answer any inquiries.

As a reminder, burning for any purpose other than a recreational fire pit is *not permitted* in Rockford Town limits at any time. This is a regulation imposed by the Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency. If you see someone violating this burning restriction, please call 509-477-4727 to report it.
