KNOW GOD THEN EXPERIENCE HIM By Vern Deadmond

The most familiar verse from the Bible for Christians and non-Christians I would have to say is John 3:16, "For God so laved the works, that He gave His only begatten San, that whoseever believeth in Him should not particle, but have everified and particle, and for the source of Christians what this Scripture meant, you would have a strong majority (if not all) tell you that it meant you would be saved and not go to hell. We know salvation is defined as the redemption of man from the bondage of sin and liability to eternal death, and the conferring on him everlasting happiness. (Webster's American Dictionary 1828)

Unfortunately, this is what we are taught salvation is from the moment we get saved and we continue to hear throughout our Christian life. And then we continue to witness to the unsaved that they need to repent or go to hell. Really? This is only the surface of what true salvation is or as Jesus states in **John 3:16**, everlasting life or eternal life. Salvation encompasses so much more of our life. I like to compare salvation to an iceberg. What most Christians know of salvation is only the tip of the iceberg, which is the part you see floating in the ocean. This is only 10-13 percent of the size of the iceberg. Look below the waterline, and you see this massive chunk of ice, but you have to make an effort to see what is below the waterline. To get a greater understanding of eternal life, we need to look more into the Word of God. Does Jesus tell us what eternal life is? It just so happens He does, but you have to look for it in the Bible. **John 17:3** states, "And this is if a state that they might three word the only three God, and Jesus Christ whem they sent."

Eternal life is to know God. Meditate on that verse for as long as you want, as you do think about how little you actually know God. To know God for whom He truly is, we have to put effort into knowing Him. Relationship doesn't just happen the first time you are introduced to someone. A relationship develops over time, you spend time around this person and you have conversations with this person. You get to know who this person is, their personality, what they believe, how they will react to circumstances, etc. How much time have you spent getting to know God? How well do you know God? Once you really get to know God, you will discover that He is not who you thought He was.

During my first year in Bible College, a personal prophetic word was spoken to me. It was nothing earth shattering at the time, it wasn't a word that knocked the socks off my feet. The person just told me "it's all about relationships." At the time it didn't make a whole lot of sense to me, but I didn't feel that the word was all together incorrect either. So, I did what I have been taught over the years, and I put that word on the shelf. I didn't discard it, nor did I go home and try to figure out what it meant. Then about a year later, I was putting together a small teaching for school and it was regarding relationship with God my Father. That word that had been spoken to me the previous year all of a sudden leapt off the shelf, and I received the revelation then that all that matters, the one thing that is most important to God – is to know Him and have a personal relationship with Him. The moment I received this revelation, that was when the earth shook and the socks were knocked off my feet as God became so real to me. I know without a doubt God desires above everything to have a personal relationship with me, this is what matters to Him.

2 Peter 1:3-4, reads "According as His divine power has given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness through the knowledge of Him that has called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these you might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."

Everything that God has given to us comes through the knowledge of Him. It is through this knowing Him that His grace operates through our life. Wait a moment, I just said that by knowing Him is what allows His grace into our lives, but the Scripture says His divine power. This is why you need to study God's Word. Look up the definition of 'grace' in a Greek dictionary, the Greek word is 'charis'. It refers to God's divine influence in our life. Influence is subtle power, so God's grace can be defined as His divine power that flows into our lives. His grace, His power, His promises all come through knowing God. If you don't ever attempt to know God, then you will never experience God's promises in your life.

When the Word speaks of knowing, this is in the sense of an intimate relationship between husband and wife. The two know each other physically, sexually, and mentally. They know things about each other that no one else knows. We are to have this type of relationship with God. Now don't go get weird and flaky and think, "How am I to know God sexually." Cast that imagination as far away as you can, that is of the devil. God wants to talk with you, as you converse with Him, He will converse with you and share such revelation with you that you will want to sit in His presence more and more. There is nothing like being in His presence, and you don't just have to be in a church service to experience His presence. I would go to church to sit in that presence, but I discovered I can be in His presence anytime I want to study His Word or talk with Him. His presence will come into my home anytime I want to invite Him in, His presence will go on walks with me if I invite Him to come along, and His presence goes with me in the car on the way to work.

The responsibility to know God falls on us. Continue reading in 2 Peter 1:5, "And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge." We are to give all diligence to knowing God, to having a relationship with Him. The first thing you need to do in getting to know God is to know His Word, when you study His Word you will begin to know God. And it is through knowing God you will be able to receive all things that pertain to eternal life.

I was born-again when I was 9 years old, and it wasn't until I was 28 that I began to serve God. But it wasn't until I was 52 when I submitted to God. What do I mean? It seems all my life; I was doing for me, not for God. And at 52, I said to God, I want to know more of You, I want to see Your power flow through my life. I quit my job and moved 800 miles away to go to Bible College to learn about Him. I went there with no job, because a job would distract me from immersing myself in Him. Once I committed and submitted to what God wanted to do in me, it changed my life completely. In the physical realm, I have never been so blessed in my life. Spiritually speaking, my eyes and ears have been rejuvenated. When I read and study God's Word, I find those printed words have life in them, and I comprehend so much more than I ever did before and I don't struggle to understand it, and I found my spirit getting so full of joy with this new understanding. I can't help but want to share it with other people.

And now I have understanding of the Hebrews 12:2 - "Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God." Jesus was able to face the Cross because He saw that by His submission, my relationship and your relationship with God was about to be restored. Jesus' final prayer before being arrested was recorded in John 17. In verse 13, He prays that we might have His joy fulfilled in ourselves. I encourage you to submit all of your life to know God with all diligence.



I really do hope that by the time that you receive this letter in your hands it finds you in the best of God's love and care! You are probably wondering who is this ... I am your brother in Christ, who reads your newsletter every month. It helps me stay strong in faith, knowing that I am not alone in the world. Looking at your pictures gives me hope, thank you for everything you do for Christianity. I was sentenced to natural life in prison in 1993 or 1994, sorry I don't keep track of time that well, but I do know I have been down 25 years.

Ten years ago, I was addicted to meth and heroine; all broken down in a prison cell, I got down on my knees and prayed for the first time in 15 years. I was going through heroine withdrawals. All I remember is praying for Christ to come into my heart and heal me. I told the Holy Spirit He was welcome here. I closed my eyes and blacked out. I remember waking up the next morning completely healed! The strong craving for heroine, gone! I no longer felt loneliness in my heart, although I was in debt to the "a certain group", I was not afraid.

I remember picking up an old Bible that somebody left behind in my cell. I just opened it to **Deuteronomy 31:6**, it said, "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you." So, I got down on my knees and I prayed to God. I said, "My Lord, my debts are now Your debts help me then to make things right with these people." At that time, I did not realize I was praying out loud. My neighbor to the left heard me. He was already aware of my situation. He was told by a friend of his to stay away from me, cause I was going to get hurt at lunch time for not paying my bills.

Back then I did not know that he was a Christian, a lot of brothers in here go under cover, cause other inmates see Christianity as a crutch. He talked to his wife, and then talked to the people I was in debt to and paid them \$800.00 to take the green light off my back. On his way back from school, before lunchtime he stopped in front of my cell and told me not to worry, that my debt has been paid! He also said that he signed me up for church! I told him that it was not possible, cause my wife just left me for another man. She said that she was done supporting my bad habits! He said, "I paid it in full!" I told him, I had no way of paying him back his money. He said, "Don't worry bro; you can repay me by staying sober and dwelling on the Word of God!"

God is just amazing. Ten years ago, I remember praying to our Lord for the law to change and for Him to set me free! Not too long ago He answered my prayer. I was convicted of two counts of first-degree murder and sentenced to two natural lifes in prison. Not too long ago I was given a celly named Crazy Eddie, a legal beagle always filing lawsuits. After reviewing my case, he said, "Dude, I'm sending you home!" The law has changed, the Supreme Court ruled! I did not know anything about the law, so he filed some paper work on my behalf. Before I knew it, I got a letter from a judge, appointing me a lawyer to represent me in my post-conviction relief. I met him in person this week, as well as a Mitigation Specialist for the second time. I don't know the words to express the feeling of God moving in my life; all I know is that it is "amazing". The attorney told me, "Your case had slipped through the cracks and that I was lucky to have filed in time."

The writer of *Hebrews* used this word to remind believers that God has given a hope that holds firm in any storm (*Hebrews 6:13-20*). Hope is a healthy attitude. Anticipating good brings comfort to the mind and heart. In contrast, a state of hopelessness is a terrible condition in which to find oneself. It's both overwhelming and depressing to think that what your facing cannot be changed or resolved. For the person who has lost all hope, life looks like a long dark tunnel going nowhere. Included in *Proverbs* is a verse that describes the result of this oppressive feeling when he says, *"Hope deferred makes the heart sick." (Proverbs 13:12*) Emotional, physical and even mental illness haunt a person who feels trapped in a bleak situation. BUT as long as there is a God, NO situation is hopeless. In Him, we have the promise of a second part of that same *Proverb* that states, *"Desire fulfilled is a tree of life."*

Believers/Overconcers for Shrist have a hope that anchors our soul. Our relationship with Jesus Christ brings us close to the throne of heaven, where we can cast ALL our burdens before an omnipotent God. Moreover, we can cling to Him through any trial that comes our way. Because of the Lord's great love, He provides strength for weary bodies, peace for anxious minds and comfort for grieving hearts. In short, He lights that darkened tunnel and tenderly guides us through trying times. Therefore, I MUST hold on to "HOPE". I'd like to share, with our Overconcers for Shrist family, a couple of very powerful teachings that I came across through , In Touch by Charles Stanley.

God Works Through Our Trials - 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

The troubles and suffering that we experience in life are not random events without purpose. God works through them for our good (*Romans 8:28*). We may not like or understand exactly what He's doing, but knowing some of His general goals helps us trust Him and cooperate so we can reap the benefits of a season of affliction.

Protection. After Paul fervently asked that his thom in the flesh be removed, God revealed to him that it was a protection from pride. We all have areas of weakness that could lead us to sin, and God in His wisdom knows how to safeguard us. Sometimes pain accomplishes what nothing else will.

Reliance. Paul's thorn, which made him weak, also taught him to endure by relying on Christ's grace and strength. In the same way, the troubles in our life bring us to the end of our rope so we'll reach out to the Lord in humble dependence. Then we are positioned to receive the divine strength He promises to provide.

Divine Perspective. When Paul finally realized what the Lord was trying to accomplish in his life, he viewed his suffering in a total different way. He stopped focusing on it as pain and hindrance and instead became content. Paul could actually rejoice because he recognized that Christ's power in him was more important than freedom from pain.

Unless we realize that God always prioritizes the eternal over the temporal, we won't see the value of pain. According to 2 Corinthians 4:17, "Momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison." Therefore, we don't lose heart.

Passing Down a Legacy of Faith - 2 Timothy 1:1-9

What do you want to pass down to your children? We'd probably like to provide a large inheritance, but there's something even more valuable - a spiritual legacy.

Paul admired the faith heritage that was passed down to Timothy by his mother and grandmother. Although Eunice and Lois could not bestow salvation on Timothy, they modeled their faith in God and His Word. Timothy's greatest inheritance was spiritual instruction and godly examples from these influential women. Mothers and fathers that want to pass along a faith legacy will make the following values a part of their life.

Principles. Know and practice biblical principles. Parents can't pass down what they don't possess, but those who love and obey God's Word will eagerly share what they've learned.

Pattern. Apply scriptural principles to your life and live them out in front of your children. A consistent pattern of obedience to God inspires children to seek Him, whereas saying one thing but doing another sets a poor example.



Persistence. Never give up in your attempts to impart spiritual knowledge. I learned this wise habit from my mother, who set out to install in me the values needed to become a godly adult. To teach a particular lesson, she'd keep telling me and showing me until she was satisfied I'd gotten the message.

It's never too late to begin crafting a faith heritage. Like Timothy's mother and grandmother, let's not settle for merely raising our children to adulthood. Instead, our goal should be to become godly examples who inspire and teach them to love and follow Jesus. First of all, beloved brothers and sisters at the Overcomers for Oficiet, I'm so very grateful for your monthly periodicals. They are a great source of inspiration. I just turned 60 this past February and with the exception of ugly teeth and thinner hair, my youth is and continues to be renewed like the eagles. Praise God!

Here's a bit of wisdom for you and all of our readers. Right NOW God is working all around you in your lives. I pray that God will open your spiritual eyes to see what He's doing. The Holy Spirit and the Word of God will instruct you and help you know when and where God is working. Once you know where He's working, you can adjust your life to join Him where He is working. Once you join God in what He is doing, you will experience Him accomplishing His activities through your life. When you enter this kind of intimate love relationship with God, you will know and do the will of God and experience Him in ways you have NEVER known Him before. Job 37:1-42:17

By spending time observing the majestic and intricate parts of God's creation, we can be reminded of His power in every aspect of our lives. (37:23)

God asked Job several questions about the animal kingdom in order to demonstrate how limited Job's knowledge really was. God was not seeking answers from Job. Instead, He was getting Job to recognize and submit to God's power and sovereignty. Only then could he hear what God was really saying to him. (39:1)

The next time you are tempted to complain to God, consider how much He loves you. Remember Job's reaction when he had his chance to speak. Are you worse off than Job or more righteous than he? Give God a chance to reveal His greater purpose for you, but remember that they may unfold over the course of your life and not at the moment you desire. (40:2-5)

Cling tightly to your faith through all your trials, and you too, will be rewarded by God, if not now, in the life to come. (42:10-11)

2 Corinthians 4:13-5:10

Our troubles should not diminish our faith or disillusion us. We should realize that there is a purpose in our suffering. Problems and human limitations have several benefits.

- 1) They remind us of Christ's suffering for us.
- They keep us from pride.
- 3) They cause us to look beyond this brief life.
- They give us opportunities to prove our faith to others.
- 5) They give God the opportunity to demonstrate His power. See your troubles as opportunities. (4:17)

The Holy Spirit within us is our guarantee that God will give us an everlasting body at the resurrection. We have eternity in us now. This truth should give us great courage and patience to endure anything we might have to experience. (5:5)

Psalm 44:9-26

The writer cried out to God to save His people because of His unfailing love. Nothing can separate us from God's love, not even death. (Romans 8:36-39) When you fear for your life, ask God for your deliverance, and remember that even death cannot separate you from Him. (44:22-26)

Proverbs 22:13

This proverb refers to an excuse a lazy person might use to avoid going to work. The excuse sounds silly to us, but that's often how our excuses sound to others. Don't rationalize laziness, take your responsibilities seriously and get to work. (22:13)

A Lesson in Thanks

"In normal life we hardly realize how much more we receive than we give, and life cannot be rich without such gratitude. It is so easy to overestimate the importance of our own achievements compared with what we owe to the help of others." -Dietrich Bonhoeffer

Giving thanks is good for our souls. Still, we all have the question. "How can I give thanks in all circumstances?" The answer is: Only by the power of the Holy Spirit. Immediately after commanding the Thessalonians to give thanks in all circumstances Paul says, "Don't put out the Spirit's fire." (1 Thessalonians 5:19) You need the fire of the Holy Spirit in your soul if you are ever going to be able to give thanks in all circumstances. Perhaps we can learn this valuable lesson from a great man who went before us.

Abraham Lincoln's life was marked with pain and difficulty.

- · When he was nine, his mother died.
- · Though he loved books, he received little formal education.
- · His sister died in childbirth.
- · At age twenty-four he was left badly in debt when a store he invested in failed.
- · When he was twenty-five the woman he loved caught fever and died--he suffered deep depression.
- · Three years later he proposed to another woman and she turned him down.
- · At thirty-four he lost the nomination for U.S. Congress--one of many elections that he would lose.
- Only one of his four sons lived to adulthood--one died just short of age four, one at age 11, one at 18.

Lincoln faced great obstacles and suffered deep depression. He would be remembered as one of the greatest presidents for his courage in ending slavery.

And we owe to him gratitude for his great Proclamation of Thanksgiving. Lincoln was not a man who grieved without hope. He knew the absolute necessity of giving thanks in all times. Consider these words, share them with your family this Thanksgiving ... Proclamation of Thanksgiving

BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. A PROCLAMATION.

The year that is drawing towards its close, has been filled with the blessings of fruitful fields and healthful skies. To these bounties, which are so constantly enjoyed that we are prone to forget the source from which they come, others have been added, which are of so extraordinary a nature, that they cannot fail to penetrate and soften even the heart which is habitually insensible to the ever watchful providence of Almighty God. In the midst of a civil war of unequaled magnitude and severity, which has sometimes seemed to foreign States to invite and to provoke their aggression, peace has been preserved with all nations, order has been maintained, the laws have been respected and obeyed, and harmony has prevailed everywhere except in the theater of military conflict; while that theater has been greatly contracted by the advancing armies and navies of the Union. Needful diversions of wealth and of strength from the fields of peaceful industry to the national defense, have not arrested the plough, the shuttle or the ship; the axe has enlarged the borders of our settlements, and the mines, as well of iron and coal as of the precious metals, have yielded even more abundantly than heretofore. Population has steadily increased, notwithstanding the waste that has been made in the camp, the siege and the battlefield; and the country, rejoicing in the consciousness of augmented strength and vigor, is permitted to expect continuance of years with large increase of freedom. No human counsel hath devised nor hath any mortal hand worked out these great things. They are the gracious gifts of the Most High God, who, while dealing with us in anger for our sins, hath nevertheless remembered mercy. It has seemed to me fit and proper that they should be solemnly, reverently and gratefully acknowledged as with one heart and one voice by the whole American People. I do therefore invite my fellow citizens in every part of the United States, and also those who are at sea and those who are sojourning in foreign lands, to set apart and observe the last Thursday of November next, as a day of Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the Heavens. And I recommend to them that while offering up the ascriptions justly due to Him for such singular deliverances and blessings, they do also, with humble penitence for our national perverseness and disobedience, commend to His tender care all those who have become widows, orphans, mourners or sufferers in the lamentable civil strife in which we are unavoidably engaged, and fervently implore the interposition of the Almighty Hand to heal the wounds of the nation and to restore it as soon as may be consistent with the Divine purposes to the full enjoyment of peace, harmony, tranquility and Union.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the United States to be affixed.

Done at the city of Washington, this Third day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixtythree, and of the Independence of the United States the Eighty-eighth.

Today, there is no hatred in my heart; I am happy and full of joy!! No drug in the world could ever replace that feeling. I want to thank you all for the Birthday Cards you have sent me these past few years, they made me feel real good inside, somebody remembered me! Even though most of my biological family has forgotten me, or passed away. My Christian family is plenty and strong. God bless you all for everything you do every day. There has always been a Christian around me to lend a helping hand, especially when I needed it most! When I was lost and addicted to drugs, they helped me replace the needle for the Word of God, and for that, I will always be grateful!!!

My only addictions are writing and listening to Gospel music. You are probably wondering why I am writing you, telling you all this. I dream a lot and that's probably cause I am always thinking, I'm real quiet. I had a dream and in that dream I was burning up alive in a lake of fire, it felt so real! I woke up dripping in sweat; I could feel that pain of the flames! All I can remember is invoking the power of Christ, but it was not Christ who pulled me out of the lake of fire, it was you! I remember you telling me that everything was going to be all right, that the flames would never touch me again. Your face was clearly from the pictures, I see your newsletter every month, but your hair was white as snow.

Please keep my in your prayers! I believe that we are all here for a reason, we all have a purpose. Mine is to help others in here overcome addictions, like I did in here. Most prisoners are not looking for the change in their lives, they are lost and blind. But there is always the possibility of finding one who is, and that is what keeps me going strong! I am doing my best to study the Word of God, to be able to spread His message behind these walls. I'm on my way to becoming a preacher, and nothing is going to stop me, not the devil or his minions!!

I'm trying to sign up for G.E.D. courses right now, I already turned in the inmate letter. Before this law came into effect, I did not care about an education, but now that I might have a release date, I really do. I should be back in the county jail fighting my case early next year, isn't that great? All thanks to our Lord Jesus Christ who heard and answered my prayer. I will continue to stay sober one day at a time, please keep me in your prayers. Any help in educating myself in the Word of God is greatly appreciated. Thank you for taking your time and reading this letter. - **I.V.**
