Family Support – Parent Education & Resource Navigation

In home and group based parent education available to families with children prenatal though age five and who meet program eligibility criteria. Parents receive one on one support and education to enhance the knowledge of child development and connection to resources in the community.

The Coordinated Intake program works directly with families to identify needs and make referrals to area partner agencies. The program maintains connections with families to ensure referrals are followed up with and services/resources are received.

Infant & Early Childhood Mental Health Consultation

Specialized consultants providing mental health training, coaching, and mentoring to early childhood professionals and families. The Southeast Iowa Early Childhood Project is a collaboration between 3 ECI Areas and covers 10 counties with 2 fulltime Family Specialists. The amount of funding below represents DHLW+M portion only. Additional funders include Lee/Van Buren ECI @ \$34,121 and Iowa/Jefferson/Keokuk ECI @ \$31,719.

Early intervention oral health services including screenings, fluoride varnish applications, educational activities, and referral, for children up to 5 years of age attending preschool and/or childcare. Family Resource Fairs & Conference

The Southeast Iowa Early Childhood Summit began as a partnership with 4 ECI Areas in 2016 and has continued annually since. The ECI Areas pool resources to provide a regional all day conference for childcare professionals in conjunction with resource fairs and family concerts. The family concerts take place over one weekend in Williamsburg, Burlington, and Keokuk. The conference includes 6 HHS approved credit hours, lunch, and appreciation gift bags.
