Greetings Parents, Students and Community Members,

Ensuring the health, safety and wellbeing of our families, students and staff, is a top priority. In order to be proactive in preventing the spread of COVID-19 we plan to implement the following safety precautions when we reopen our campus for full time student learning on August 10, 2020.

#### Implementing a temperature screening protocol

- Everyone coming into our facility for school business will be screened.
- Anyone with a temperature over 99 degrees and/or with affirmative answers to the COVID-19 symptom questionnaire will not be allowed to enter our facility.

#### Provide hand sanitizer in common areas, offices and classrooms

• Good personal hygiene, including handwashing will be encouraged and signage will be posted.

### Enhanced cleaning and sanitizing of all areas

- All areas will be cleaned and sanitized at the end of each day.
- Additionally, any space found to have been occupied by a person with COVID-19 symptoms will be cleaned and sanitized as soon as it is reasonably possible.

#### Establishing a "sick-area" clinic space for students and staff

 Any student who is found to have a temperature greater than 99 degrees and/or other COVID-19 symptoms will remain in the school clinic and will be provided with a face covering to wear until parental pick up can be arranged.

Also, please be aware that this policy is subject to change as we move through the next few weeks.
