Barbara Fei Off to America

Barbara Fei, well-known in Hong Kong music circles, leaves Hong Kong early this month for a two or three month singing tour of the West Coast of America. The high point of her trip will occur at dawn on Easter morning when she will appear on the stage in the famed Pasadena Rose Bowl as the soloist at the Sunrise Service, the only time apart from the New Year's Day football classic that the 105,000 seat stadium is filled to the brim.

Miss Fei, who is really Mrs. James Coe, is going on this tour of more than 20 cities at her own expense, or rather her husband's, to raise funds for the Oriental Missionary Society which supports refugee churches and hospitals in Hong Kong, Taiwan, Korea, Japan and the Philippine Islands.

Miss Fei is known by many in Hong Kong through her many appearances on the Concert Hall stage in the City Hall and on TV and, more recently, for the fine performances of the Allegro Singers, a group of 40 she has formed from her present and former pupils.



費明儀旅遊美國

費明儀，在本港的音樂界卓著聲譽，於本月初離港至美國西岸作二至三個月的歌唱演奏旅遊，她這一次的演奏旅遊其最重要的節目厥為於復活節的黎明在著名派司丁那玫瑰廣場 Pasadena Rose Bowl 參加日出祈禱會的單人獨唱，該廣場有十萬零五千座位，除元旦足球比賽會外，從未宣告滿座。

費女士在實際上應被稱呼為許樂羣夫人，此行將經歷二十個以上的城市，完全出於自費，也可以說由她丈夫所供給，其目的為籌募東方教會供應香港的難民教堂及醫院的經費，並包括台灣、韓國、日本及菲列賓地區在內。

在香港費女士曾在大會堂登台演唱並在電台出現多次，最近又有費明儀合唱團之組織，係由費女士的高足及過去的高足四十人所組成者。
