For Introduction

\* Allowing tattoo and body piercing establishments: This was discussed and rejected several years ago, but with a change in acceptance (30% of the general population has some type of tattoo) and beauty salons want to use “microblading” (insert a dye under the eyebrow to permanently darken the area), this passed.

\* Expansion of businesses in homes: Because of the pandemic, many entrepreneurs are now operating “businesses” from their homes. These include: beauty saloons, personal training, physical therapy, etc. Many would need to be licensed by the state with the city conducting inspections; there would be limitations on the number of people present; only one business per dwelling unit; no outward changes to the dwelling unit; parking would have to be limited; etc. Passed.
