THE AMERICAN SADDLEBRED HORSE BREEDERS FUTURITY OF COLORADO

Open only to registered American Saddlebred Horses

PURPOSE: Futurities are held to encourage the breeding and showing of American Saddlebred Horses. The value of the foal entered in the Futurity is enhanced by having its earning potential increased; the value of the sire and dam may also be enhanced by successful progeny shown in Futurities.

WHAT COLTS AND FILLES ARE ELIGIBLE? See the schedule below for nomination/eligibility requirements. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER TO PROVIDE THE FUTURITY WITH PROOF OF ASHA REGISTRATION BY THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW.

<u>WEANLING ELIGIBILITY</u> – To keep a weanling eligible to show in the Two-Year-Old or Three-Year-Old Colorado Futurity, the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- 1. The sire and dam must be nominated to the Colorado Futurity by December 31 of the year in which the foal is born.
- 2. A wearling fee of \$50.00 must be paid to the Colorado Futurity on or before December 31 of the year the foal is born.
- 3. The foal must be registered (or application for registration postmarked) by December 31 of the foaling year. Pending applications (including DNA testing and a registration number assigned) must be completed before March 31 of the yearling year.

YEARLING ELIGIBILITY – To keep a yearling eligible to show in the Colorado Futurity, the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- 1. The horse must have been nominated as a weanling, and all conditions and requirements must have been fulfilled.
- 2. One yearling payment of \$50.00 must be paid to the Colorado Futurity on or before December 31 of the foal's yearling year.

TWO-YEAR-OLD ELIGIBILITY - To keep a two-year-old eligible to show in the Colorado Futurity, the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- 1. The horse must have been nominated as a weanling, and all conditions and requirements for a weanling and yearling must have been fulfilled.
- 2. One two-year-old payment of \$50.00 must be paid to the Colorado Futurity on or before July 15 of the foal's two-year-old year. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10.00 late fee per horse.

Effective in 2020, ANY two-year-old not nominated to the Colorado Futurity in the foaling year, will be allowed to be nominated for a one-time payment of \$300. This payment must be received or postmarked on or before July 15 of the horse's two-year-old year. If the sire and/or dam were not originally nominated, an additional fee of \$50.00 for the sire nomination and \$25.00 for the dam nomination must also be paid by the above-mentioned deadline.

THREE-YEAR-OLD ELIGIBILITY — To keep a three-year-old eligible to show in the Colorado Futurity, the following conditions must be fulfilled:

1. The horse must have been nominated as a weanling, and all conditions and requirements for a weanling, yearling and two-year-old must have been fulfilled.

2. One two-year-old payment of \$50.00 must be paid to the Colorado Futurity on or before July 15 of the foal's three-year-old year. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10.00 late fee per horse.

Effective in 2020, ANY three-year-old not nominated to the Colorado Futurity in the foaling year, will be allowed to be nominated for a one-time payment of \$350. This payment must be received or postmarked on or before July 15 of the horse's three-year-old year. If the sire and/or dam were not originally nominated, an additional fee of \$50.00 for the sire nomination and \$25.00 for the dam nomination must also be paid by the above-mentioned deadline.

<u>HOW SHOWN – TWO-YEAR OLDS</u>: IN-HARNESS entries shall be shown in a COMBINED class for fillies and colts. Two-year-old entries shall be shown in accordance with AHSA rules and can be shown in a 2 wheel or 4-wheel buggy. Entries will be shown at the walk and park trot both ways of the ring. Either a flat walk or park walk is acceptable. Horses may be shown with or without a set tail.

<u>HOW SHOWN – THREE-YEAR-OLDS:</u> UNDER SADDLE entries shall be shown in a COMBINED class of fillies and colts and in a full bridle (Weymouth or Pelham). Three-year-old entries shall be shown in accordance with AHSA rules. Entries will be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Either a flat walk or park walk is acceptable. Horses may be shown with or without a mane and with or without a set tail. **All entries will be stripped**.

HOW THE PRIZES ARE DIVIDED: All divisions shall payback as follows: monies will be placed in the division for which they are paid (i.e. two-year-old monies will be paid to the two-year-old class and three-year-old monies will be paid to the three-year-old class). Stallion and mare nomination fees and weanling and yearling payments will be divided equally between the two-year-old and three-year-old classes. Monies are then divided so that the winner of the class shall take 40%, second 25%, third 15% and fourth 12.5%, and fifth 7.5%. All nomination fees and other moneys raised shall be paid out in prize money, after expenses. If a class does not fill, total prize money shall be paid out by increasing the above amounts according to the same scale. Dues collected may be used for Saddlebred Futurity promotional activities.

WHERE AND WHEN TO PAY FEES: See outline above. All fees received by the Secretary of the Futurity must be postmarked by the schedule outlined above. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10.00 late fee per horse the two and three-year-old year ONLY.

<u>LIABILITY:</u> There will be NO return of payment paid. Any entry paid by a check, which does not clear (bad check), shall be null and void and the animal(s) in question will be ineligible. **If such a check can be made good with a cashier's check or money order by the June 15th deadline (or grace period of July 1st), the entry will then be accepted with a \$50.00 return check fee. The right is reserved to reject any entry, and to debar any entry from competition for failure to comply with the conditions of the Colorado Futurity.**
