The Committee is anticipating a large number of quilt submissions for the 2022 Show. Please submit your entries as early as possible. The total number of quilt entries and sizes determine the total number of quilts that can be displayed. The Committee has decided on a two (2) entry limit and the February 15, 2022 deadline may be adjusted if the number of quilts submitted exceed the total space available earlier than expected. All entries are date-stamped and will be accepted based on those dates.

All the items must be delivered to the Community Center on Thursday, March 24, 2022, between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. You will be given a receipt for each item entered into the show.

Items entered in the show will be available for pickup at the show entrance on March 26th from 6 pm -6:45 p.m. A receipt must be presented to pick up your entry.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. Items entered should not have been exhibited in a previous Georgetown Quilt Show. Entries should be made or owned by a Williamson or surrounding counties resident or a Handcrafts Unlimited artisan or volunteer.
- 2. Quilt forms may be obtained at Handcrafts Unlimited or at the Quilt Show website at www.handcrafts-unlimited.com/georgetown-quilt-show.html. The entry form may be copied.
- 3. Please use one form for each item entered. The completed form must be legible.
- 4. No unfinished items will be accepted for display in the show.
- 5. To aid in the planning of the show, a picture of your entry **MUST** accompany each entry form. Acceptable pictures include photos, scans, digital photo printouts and Polaroid's. The photo should be no larger than 4" x 6".
- 6. Each quilt entry must be placed in a separate pillowslip with the entrant's name, address and phone number securely attached to the back of the quilt and to the pillowslip. Entries without a pillowslip will not be accepted.
- 7. Cancellations should be made by calling Susan Janes at (512) 258-5135.
- 8. For security purposes, the exhibit area of the Community Center will close at 5 pm on Saturday, March 26th; to allow the show committee members and other volunteers time to prepare the items for pickup. Receipts are required to pick up all entered items. A representative may pick up an item in your place, but the receipt will be required to ensure that each piece in our keeping is properly returned. We ask for patience as we carefully ensure the safekeeping of your entries. Please mark your calendar with these dates. Items will be available for pickup on March 26th from 6 p.m. 6:45 pm.
- 9. People's Choice balloting will close at 2 pm, on March 26th. The list of winners will be posted and awards will be given out at 4:00 pm.
- 10. Entries will be accepted until available display space is full. Each entry form will be date-stamped with the receipt date.
- 11. Special hangers are used to display each quilt no hanging sleeve is required.
