## SKYLANDS STADIUM 30 ${ }^{\text {TH }}$ ANNIVERSARY CHARITY AUCTION

To celebrate the 30th anniversary of Skylands Park, Al Dorso, current owner of Skylands Stadium, and the ballpark's founder, Rob Hilliard, are collaborating on a charity auction of Hilliard's sports memorabilia. Proceeds will benefit SCARC, an area non-profit organization dedicated to empowering \& supporting individuals with developmental disabilities and their families, and the non-profit University of Virginia Club of Northern NJ. (Hilliard, a Jersey City native \& former Vernon Twp. resident, is a 1974 UVA alumnus).

The auction is being held in two phases: an initial online phase (April 16-June 9) and a silent, in-person phase at Skylands Stadium (June 14-15). The top bid for each item at the close of the online phase on June 9 will be the starting bid of the silent phase on June 14 .

## BIDDING

Note that certain items have a minimum bid. This will be clearly indicated in the description of each item and by a $\$$ at the end of the item code.

If the items are part of a bundle, codes will end with an "M." Single items end in an "s."

## Online Auction Phase

The catalog below shows all items up for bid, along with a description of each item and its unique code. If you wish to bid on one or more items, (a) go to the CONTACT page of the Web site, (b) provide your full name and email address in the appropriate spaces, (c) under SUBJECT type "Auction," (d) under MESSAGE list the code(s) for the item(s) on which you want to place a bid followed by the dollar amount in parentheses, e.g., MLB85s (\$20). Use a separate line for each item on which you are bidding. For each day of the online auction period (April $16^{\text {th }}$ thru June $10^{\text {th }}$ ), the highest bid for each item will be posted in an Excel page on the Web site by 9:00 a.m. Eastern the following day.

## In-person Silent Auction Phase

On Friday and Saturday, June $14^{\text {th }} \& 15^{\text {th }}$, auction items will be displayed at a specified location in Skylands Stadium. At a check-in desk in the silent-auction display area, fans interested in bidding on items will be given a coupon with a serial number and asked to complete a form with their name, phone number, email address and their coupon number. There will be a bid page underneath each auction item. Fans will write their coupon number and bid amount immediately below the latest bid. Your bid must be at least $\$ 1$ higher than that last bid. Fans may bid multiple times on an item until the auction is closed. Final bids will be accepted no later than one hour after the first pitch of the June $15^{\text {th }}$ Sussex County Miners-Evansville Otters game, scheduled to start at 6:35 p.m.

## WINNING BIDS POSTED; BIDDERS CONTACTED

Winning bids will be posted by $10 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$. on Sunday, June 16., on the Excel spreadsheet provided at https://www.jerzeywahoomedia.com. If the highest bid was made during the silent auction phase, the coupon serial number will appear as well. If the winning bid was made during the online phase, the phrase "online bid" will appear. In either case, winners will be contacted by Rob Hilliard to discuss the transaction \& delivery process. At that time, Rob will confirm donation amounts.

## TRANSACTIONS

Winning bidders will have until Tuesday, July $2^{\text {nd }}$ at 5 p.m. Eastern time, to make two payments:

- First, to SCARC for 85\% of the total winning bid. Simply call the SCARC Foundation at 973-383-7442 and mention you have a donation in connection with a winning bid from the Skylands Stadium charity auction.
- Second, to UVA Club of Northern NJ for $15 \%$ of the total winning bid. (a) Visit the UVA Club of Northern NJ page at https://engagement.virginia.edu/clubs/northern-new-jersey; (b) click on the "GIVE NOW" button; (c) under "Amount" provide the dollars \& cents equal to $15 \%$ of the winning bid; (d) under "Designation/Make your selection" type "UVA Club of Northern New Jersey"; (e) provide name/street address/country/mail code and email, and (f) choose your method of payment.
