AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF HIGHWAYS AND STREETS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW MUNICH, MINNESOTA AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

The Council of the village of New Munich, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Careless Driving: No person shallmoperate or halt any vehiclem upon a street or highway within the Village of New Munich, Minnesota, carelessly or heedlessly in disregard of the rights or safety of others or in a manner so as to endanger or be limitally to endanger any person or property.

Section 2. Speed Regulations: No person driving a vehicle within the village of New Munich, shall drive the same at a speed agreater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions and having regard to the actual and patential hazards then existing. In every event speed shall be so restricted as may be necessary in order to avoid colliding with any person, vehicle or other conveyance on or entering the highway of street in compliance with legal requirements and the duty of all

persons to use due care but in any case not to exceed a speed of 30 miles per hour.
Section 3. Driving under the influence of liquor: No person shall drive or pperate any vehicle on any street or highway within the village while under the influence of liquor and no person shall consume liquor while an occupant of a vehicle upon any street or highway in the village. Section 4. Driving bicycles: No person shall operate a bicycle on the

sidewalks of said village of New Munich at any time.

To the curb and with the right hand wheels of such vehicle within 12 inches of the curb and with the right hand wheels of such vehicle within 12 inches of the curb, except such vehicles as shall park upon the West side of Main Street shapark diagonally in a southwesterly direction, touching the curb and in all cases within spaces marked by Ohief of Police.

Section 2.
