

Section 1: A City Marshal shall be appointed whose term of office shall be Ordinance No. 5-60 ^{after the first Tuesday} the 1st ~~Monday~~ ^{Monday} of ~~April~~ ^{April} of each odd numbered year. An ordinance providing for the appointment, salary and term of office of City Attorney, City Clerk, City Treasurer, Police Judge, City Engineer, City Marshal, Fire Chief, Street Commissioner and Water-works Superintendent, a Sexton for the Cemetery and an Engineer at the City Pumping Station, for the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 1: A City Attorney shall be appointed whose term of office shall be Two years from the First ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ ^{Monday} of ~~April~~ ^{April} in each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ~~One Hundred~~ ^{One Hundred} Dollars per annum, payable monthly; ~~and not less than _____ Dollars nor more than _____ Dollars for each conviction in the Police court and not less than _____ Dollars for each case in the district court in which the City of Garnett shall be a party, in Anderson or any other County in the State.~~

~~And not less than _____ Dollars nor more than _____ Dollars for each case in which the City shall be a party in the Supreme Court of the state of Kansas, and \$5.00 Dollars for each case in which the City shall be a party in any Justice of Peace court of this state and his actual expenses in his attendance upon any court where the City shall be a party. Payable when any of such cases are finally disposed of.~~

Section 2: A City Clerk shall be appointed whose term of office shall be for Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ ^{Monday} of ~~April~~ ^{April} of each odd numbered year, and whose salary shall be ~~Four Hundred~~ ^{Four Hundred and Seventy} Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Section 3: A City Treasurer shall be appointed whose term of office shall be Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ ^{Monday} of ~~April~~ ^{April} of each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ~~Seventy~~ ^{Seventy} ~~Dollars~~ ^{plus} Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Section 4: a Police Judge shall be appointed whose term of office shall be Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ ^{Monday} of ~~April~~ ^{April} of each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ~~Fifteen~~ ^{Fifteen} Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Section 5: A City Engineer, shall be appointed whose term of office shall be for Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ ^{Monday} of ~~April~~ ^{April} of each odd numbered years and who shall receive a salary of ~~Three~~ ^{Three} Dollars per ~~annum~~ ^{day}, ~~payable monthly~~ ^{for time actually employed.}

Section 6: A City Marshal shall be appointed whose term of office shall be for Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ of ^{April} ~~April~~ of each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ^{fourty} ~~Five Hundred~~ Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Section 7: A Fire-chief shall be appointed whose term of office shall be for Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ of ^{April} ~~April~~ of each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ^{Two} ~~Two~~ Dollars ^{for each time the department is called into service for fire alarm} per annum payable monthly.

Section 8: A Water-works Superintendent and Street Commissioner shall be appointed whose term of office shall be for Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ of ^{April} ~~April~~ of each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ^{Six Hundred} ~~Six Hundred~~ Dollars per annum, payable monthly. ^{Thirty Dollars from the general fund and Twenty Dollars from the water works fund}

Section 9: An Engineer and Fireman at the City Pumping Station shall be appointed whose term of office shall be for Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ of ^{April} ~~April~~ of each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ^{Six Hundred} ~~Six Hundred~~ Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Section 10: A Sexton shall be appointed for the Cemetery whose term of office shall be for Two years from the 1st ^{after the first Tuesday} ~~Monday~~ of ^{April} ~~April~~ each odd numbered year and who shall receive a salary of ^{Two} ~~Two~~ Dollars per ^{day for} ~~annum~~ ^{Time actually employed by the City.} payable monthly.

Section 11: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners. ^{and its publication}
