This survey will help local and state emergency planners know how to target resources based on communities' needs so everyone can be better prepared and able to recover during extreme weather events, flooding, and hurricanes. The survey is through the Community Resiliency Information System or CRIS.

• City facilities reopened Oct. 5, including utility bill and traffic citation payment offices, and:

--Recreation centers

--Gyms and fitness centers will open and room rentals will be available. Classes and programming will resume at a later date.

--Each center will have its own opening plan and Covid-19 mitigation procedures.

--Libraries will reopen with limited hours. Services like computer access, curbside pickup, and book browsing will differ among library locations. Onsite programming, meeting rooms and children's play areas will resume at a later date.

-- Events will resume: Event organizers will be required to comply with CDC guidelines and local health authorities when hosting. Events ranging from the Grand Prix to a wedding in a city park will return to standard permitting and approval processes.
