

## COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

### POLICY

Community use of school facilities for the promotion of legitimate community, educational, recreational and cultural activities are a substantial investment of community resources and should be offered as a service to the community, provided that those uses are secondary to the operation of the activities provided pursuant to the direction of the Board of Education.

As a result, organized and recognized school and community groups may utilize these facilities upon the approval of the Superintendent of Schools, in which case the Superintendent's designee is authorized to approve and schedule the use of school facilities in accordance with the policies of the Board and within the prescriptions of the following Board of Education "Rules and Regulations for the Community use of School Facilities."

Community groups are defined as groups providing 50% or more of their services to District residents.

In addition, use of school equipment by community groups will be secondary to its use in connection with the various school purposes and will not interfere with them. No school equipment may be removed from the school premises. School equipment may not be used or borrowed for personal use.
