PLUMAS-SIERRA SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Applicant from an agriculture family may choose any course of study.
- 2. Applicant from a non-agricultural family must be enrolled in studies relating to Agriculture as defined in the cover letter to graduating seniors.
- 3. Applicant must be a resident of Plumas or Sierra County for a least one year at the time of application.
- 4. Applicant must be a graduating senior of a Plumas or Sierra County school. Applications will be accepted during senior year.
- 5. The applicant must have demonstrated high moral character, good citizenship and dedication to American ideals.
- 6. The applicant shall have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average at time of application.
- 7. Applicant must enroll as a full-time student at a 2- or 4-year college or trade school.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Submit an Official and Signed Transcript of records and high school grades with application.
- 2. On another sheet of paper, a list of extra-curricular activities you participated in and include dates and offices held in those activities.
- 3. Along with the completed application form, submit THREE letters of recommendation from persons other than the applicant's family giving information about the applicant's character and achievements.
- 4. Appear for a personal interview with the Plumas-Sierra Cattle Women's Scholarship Committee in May.
- 5. The money will be available upon proof of registration after the fall semester begins. It must include the name of school and proof of full-time status.
- 6. Submit an essay of 500 or less detailing how your field of study will contribute to the agricultural community and the beef industry.
