

### Reconcile Yourself To God | Sunday Service 03/30/2025



Over the years we have watched as people of all walks of life fell from greatness into despair and even imprisonment because they failed to be humble and contrite. Often times they failed to admit to their mistakes and this would cost them dearly in the end.

For 40 years the Israelites wandered in the desert. The celebration had not been conducted in nearly all that time, but now it is time to resume the

remembrance because God "has rolled away the reproach of Egypt" (Joshua 5:9) from them. Jesus tells the parable of the Son who squanders his inheritance and the Father receives him back. In each case a humble and contrite heart is needed to return to full grace. Paul in his second letter to the Corinthians implores them to reconcile themselves to God.

During this time of Lent you and I are called to that same repentance and reconciliation today. The Lord has a wonderful land full of milk and honey awaiting us, but we must first admit that we are sinners in need of the savior Jesus Christ.
