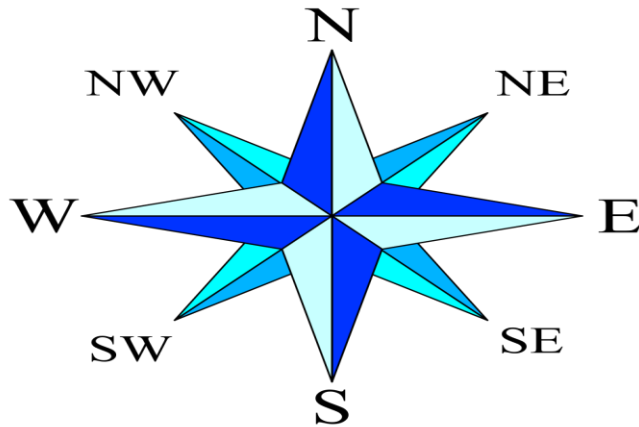

## Directions

**Follow the ICW down the Caloosahatchee River to Marker 92. Turn north, and follow the channel toward Tarpon Point. Follow the markers along the shoreline and turn right. Proceed down the short channel, and turn left toward Cape Harbour. The lock is just a short distance. Be aware of depths, and safe distance between boats until it is your turn to enter the lock. When you complete locking through, contact one of the cruise leaders on channel 16 who will assist you with docking. Cape Harbour does not provide docking assistance, so it is not worth contacting them by radio. When you are done tying up, walk up to the office (located in the boat storage building next to Rumrunner's) and register with the harbormaster.**
