FERTILE HATCH EGGS

White Leghorn fertile hatch eggs are available for school and research projects. Egg cost varies with quantity. There is a mailing and handling charge unless eggs can be delivered to dealer feed mills on their delivery route days. Ask for details.

CHICKEN NUTRITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Sunnyside Jumbo Broilers are an extremely fast growing meat type chicken and must be fed a quality high energy broiler ration of 23% protein for 4 weeks and a 20% grower ration to finish. Leghorns and dual purpose birds need a 20% starter to 8 weeks and a 17% grower to finish. Starting the third day, lightly sprinkle baby chick (#1) grit on the feed daily. Use an open feeder tray the first few days to give chicks easy access to feed. Feed should include coccidiosis prevention. Vitamins and Electrolytes are recommended at 1/2 teaspoon per gallon to start chicks.

To help avoid leg problems and heart attacks consider mildly restricting feed to your Jumbo Broilers. Starting at 2 weeks let Broilers run out of feed or remove feeders by 8 p.m. It really works!

CHICKEN HELPFUL MANAGEMENT HINTS

Always know the brooding temperature. A thermometer is your cheapest investment. A temperature of 90° is recommended to start chicks. Reduce temperature 5° a week until 70° room temperature is reached. Chicks should be evenly spread around heat source. Allow at least 1/2 square foot per bird to start. For growing birds, allow at least 1 1/2 square feet per bird. You can tell when chicks are comfortable by the way they move around eating and drinking. A 250 watt heat bulb 18-24 inches above the floor to start for each 80 chicks or 40 turkeys is recommended.

Litter must remain clean and dry. Shavings, peat moss and rice hulls work best. Avoid newspaper or straw - they cause leg problems.

Keep air fresh with no drafts. A chick guard 18 inches high for first 10 days helps.

Allow one gallon of fresh water for each 50 chicks.


The feeders and waterers should be raised as chickens grow keeping them level to chickens back.

TURKEYS

BROAD BREASTED WHITE

Commercial turkeys raised today are the large Broad Breasted White variety. Females can be expected to weigh 16-18 lbs. in 14-16 weeks and Toms 30 lbs. in 18-20 weeks.

TURKEY NUTRITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Feed and water immediately upon arrival. Start turkeys on a 28% medicated starter to 8 weeks. 9 through 16 weeks feed a 21% turkey grower and 17 weeks to slaughter feed a 16% turkey finisher. Add Vitamins and Electrolytes in drinking water to start.

TURKEY HELPFUL MANAGEMENT HINTS

Raise turkeys apart from chickens for disease prevention. Turkeys starting are more sensitive to temperature and drafts, however, most growing recommendations for chicks also apply to turkeys.

DUCKLINGS

MALLARDS

The color pattern is the same as Rouens but Mallards are much smaller and the meat has a gamey taste not found in domestic ducks.

The Giant White Pekins are the ducks most in demand. They are very hardy and extremely fast growing with 7 pound weights in 8 to 9 weeks. Being white feathered, they dress out nicely.

ROUENS

The large type Rouens are fast growing ducks reaching 7-8 pound weights in about 9 weeks. They carry dark feathers that resemble mallard ducks. The drakes carry greenish heads with gray bodies, the hens are brown.

DUCK NUTRITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Start ducklings on a commerical duck starter for 3-4 weeks. If not available, a good **non-medicated** chick starter will do. Additional grain can gradually be added to the starter so that after 8 weeks a 14-15% protein grow ration is fed.

DUCK HELPFUL MANAGEMENT HINTS

Give plenty of clean drinking water in fountains deep enough to enable them to wash their bills. Do not let them get into the water and become chilled. Remove all wet spots and replace with dry litter as needed. When using a heat lamp provide one 250 watt heat bulb for each 30 ducklings.

RECOMMENDED PRECAUTIONS WHEN HANDLING AND CARING FOR LIVE POULTRY

Live poultry can be a source of potentially harmful bacteria.

The following are safe handling tips:

- Thoroughly wash hands with soap and water after handling anything in live poultry environment.
- Clean poultry equipment frequently.
- Keep live poultry and their equipment outside of your home.
- Do not eat or drink around poultry or their environment.
- Supervise children when they handle poultry. Make sure that
 they do not put hands or fingers into their mouths. Young
 children under the age of five and others with weakened
 immune systems should be cautious when handling poultry.
- Do not nuzzle or kiss poultry.

NEW FDA REGULATIONS

Due to the recent decision by the FDA limiting antibiotic treatment of all livestock, including poultry, we have posted information on our website some recommendations for treatment of common poultry problems without the use of antibiotics.
