Per Capita—What is it & Why Do it???

Many have asked questions about per capita, What is it? What does it support?

The Per Capita is an important aspect of how we do church. Presbyterians are proud of how our convictions inform our church function and organizational structure. As Presbyterians, we believe in "the priesthood of all believers" and acknowledge that all are called to bring their gifts and talents to God (1 Peter 2:9). And so, we champion this idea "call" throughout all levels of our denomination. On the local church level, church members are called to serve as Elders, Deacons, and pastors. Elders

and pastors of churches in geographical groupings gather as Presbyteries.

There will be a Per Capita envelope in February's envelope mailing. <u>The cost per member is \$42.90</u> In a small but significant way, consider Per Capita as one way YOU and MARS UP CHURCH might be able to respond along with other Christians and churches across the nation, proclaiming the Gospel message that sin, separation and disunity will not have the final answer for us, our church, our denomination OR our world. The final answer is fully in the sovereign hands of God. Indeed, God is greater and more powerful than our broken and foolish ways of sin.
