President's Note

For a February at the Lake, we have had a very busy month.

At the February board meeting, there was a decision made to delay the closing of the valve at least two and maybe 4 weeks. (No earlier than March 15 and no later than April 4). Listening to members both formally thru email and other communications or informally, at the water cooler as they would say, is extremely important to the board's decision-making policies. This is exactly why the decision was made to try something that has been rejected in the past. I personally have been in multiple discussions with members this year, and past years for that matter, about being flexible with the valve closure so that shoreline preservation and dock projects would have a chance to be completed. In the past, the reasons for adherence to March 1 always had to do with making sure the lake would achieve summer pool and of course, the old cliche "we have always done it that way". It has even been suggested that an exceptionally dry summer would somehow be mitigated by an early valve closure. I have been on the board for 5 years, and every year, there was a discussion about leaving the valve open and every year, there was an overwhelming rejection for some of the reasons above and I know the lack of flexibility then is being touted as precedent now. At this year's February board meeting, there was a long discussion before taking this road and based on requests from members, the number of projects in process that were in jeopardy and a willingness to try something different than in years past, we thought we'd give flexibility a try. I know that certain members will view this as unfair or even unwise and I have heard both positive and negative feedback regarding our decision. As I said above, we welcome feedback, whether it be approving or disapproving and document it for future discussions and decisions. It may be that if the wet weather persists, we will just go ahead and close the valve. As an aside, I also had a discussion with our Fish and Wildlife folks to check to see if that might affect the fish in any way or any other wildlife for that matter and was told unequivocally that the valve being closed a little later should not have any effect. While we're on the subject of shoreline projects, heavy rains this past week made it a abundantly clear that we need to work on shoreline preservation for our properties and erosion that may be happening in the gullies that flow through our properties. A good suggestion for the gullies is to place hay bales or fallen tree trunks perpendicular to gully and have that act as a catch for some of the dirt washing down. A number of land-owners have employed that strategy with good results. The board is actively discussing a dredging plan for some of the coves here at the lake but even if we can implement dredging, that will all be for nothing if we don't take better steps to protect our shore-lines. Even modest adjustments can go a long way so please think about a proactive approach for your property. I know we are discussing doing the same for lake-owned property.

We are going to reestablish a Spring cleanup day. In the past, we have used that day to plant flowers at the front gate, do some painting projects and lake dock repair. We hope to get good participation this year and really make some nice improvements to the lake. The planned date is April 23. IN next month's newsletter, we will have more details.

Quick note from our roads people. We try to stay on top of the potholes that appear from time to time on the roads. Bruce drives the roads at least once a week to check for potholes. It's difficult to stay ahead of them. Please slow down a little around them and that may minimize the size that some of them get before we have a chance to address them.

Sadly, for personal reasons, one of our board members, George Schneider, needs to step down effective this last month and will need to be replaced for his term remainder. George has been a valued member of the board and will be missed. He still is and will be heavily involved in many projects here at the lake. That said we will be appointing a new board member at the next board meeting. If you have any interest in the open slot, please send me an email. I am at wef5858@aol.com. You an also attend the meeting and discuss the matter with us.

Security

I would like to remind everyone that start- I would like to remind everyone that in ing April 1st the 2021 stickers will no longer gain you entry into the lake. If you do not have your 2022 sticker on your ve- as 445 Elk Lake Resort Road and then hicle by April 1st be prepared to get stopped and asked to show your license to prove you are the property owner. If you have a 2021 sticker on your vehicle April 1st and are not the property owner you will not be able to enter the lake unless you have a pass. This being said please make sure you and your family members have your 2022 stickers on your vehicles by April 1st.

If your dues are not paid by April 1st you will also no longer be able to write passes or use any of the common areas. The guards have a list of those members who have not paid at the gate.

If you have children who are 18 or older and you would like for them to be able to write passes you need to fill out the paperwork at the gate. This needs to be renewed every year. This is only for children who are 18 or older and not for any other family members.

If you have your lawn contracted to be mowed or your house contracted to be cleaned, you will need to fill out a new contractors form at the gate. These need to be renewed every year.

Speaking of contractor forms, if you are having any work done on your property or are expecting a delivery you need to let the gate know and fill out a contractor form. Contractor forms allow the gate to know who is allowed to go to your property and the length of time that they will be coming and going to and from your property. It also allows the gate to know who and where everyone who enters the lake to work is supposed to be.

the event you need to call 911 please do the following. Call 911 give your address give your lot number and road name. Also if you are able call the gate and let them know. Another reminder having your lot number on your property by the road is important. Emergency personnel look for lot numbers. In an emergency seconds count.

I would like to take a few minutes each month and tell you a little something about each of our guards. I will start with Janetta New, our 8-4 guard. Janetta has been with Elk Lake for 8 years. She is the head guard. Her duties include keeping all the paperwork up to date and in order and making out the schedule and keeping the guards up to date on any changes or new procedures. Is that all she does. no it's not. Janetta calls full time members to check on them if she hasn't seen or heard from them in a day or so. She worries when they don't follow their usual routines. Janetta will try and get help for someone if they are stuck, broke down or have fallen and can't get up. When emergency vehicles come in Janetta is ready with a map and directions. Janetta deals with contractors, guests and packages daily. If you have ever spent any time at the gate at all you know how difficult things can get and how busy things can

get. Janetta always has a smile and kind word for everyone. So if you don't already know her be sure to stop and introduce yourself.


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
