

Epiphany Sunday

Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12

The Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord

The word Epiphany comes from the Greek word Epiphaneia, which means appearance or manifestation in English. The Solemnity of the Epiphany of Jesus invites us to center our minds on Christ's manifestation to the world, how God manifests to us through Jesus and how we show Christ to others through our deeds and words. Last week we welcomed him into the world in our numerous Christmas activities. As the Magi rejoiced in today's Gospel, the news of the birth of the new king did not go down well in the hearts of king Herod and some elders of the Jews. Matthew narrates how the birth of Christ was both a source of peace to many and a heart breaking to Herod and his cohorts.

The visitation of the Magi or the three kings from the east showed the birth of the new king — Jesus — was a worldwide news. The Bible did not tell us the names of those wise men, but to differentiate them from other wise men, the scripture called them the Magi. The wise men's three gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh portrayed Christ as the anointed king of the universe. While the three wise kings from the east accepted Christ as the king of all kings, Herod saw Jesus as his rival. Hence, as the three kings were praising God for the birth of Christ, Herod was planning to eliminate him.

Like the above biblical story, today there are some who are persecuting Christ like Herod and many who are identifying with him in many ways like the Magi. As Christians, the solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord reminds us that Christ manifests himself to us daily in the Blessed Sacrament, and in his other gifts and blessings. Although we may not have gold, frankincense and myrrh like the wise men, we can give Christ our hearts. Like the star of the Bethlehem, let us resolve to fully commit ourselves to Christ, and let us show him to others in any little way we can. As we thank God for His manifestation to us, Jesus wants us to be his Epiphany to our neighbors by our corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

Evangelio: Mateo 2:1-12

La solemnidad de la epifanía del Señor

La palabra Epifanía proviene de la palabra griega Epiphaneia, que significa aparición o manifestación en inglés. La solemnidad de la Epifanía de Jesús nos invita a centrar nuestras mentes en la manifestación de Cristo al mundo, cómo Dios se nos manifiesta a través de Jesús y cómo mostramos a Cristo a los demás a través de nuestros hechos y palabras. La semana pasada lo recibimos en el mundo en nuestras numerosas actividades navideñas. Mientras los Reyes Magos se regocijaban hoy en el Evangelio, la noticia del nacimiento del nuevo rey no cayó bien en los corazones del rey Herodes y de algunos ancianos de los judíos. Mateo narra cómo el nacimiento de Cristo fue una fuente de paz para muchos y un corazón desgarrador para Herodes y sus cohortes.

La visita de los Reyes Magos o de los tres reyes del este mostró el nacimiento del nuevo rey — Jesús — era una noticia mundial. La Biblia no nos dijo los nombres de esos sabios, pero para diferenciarlos de otros sabios, la Escritura los llamó los Magos. Los tres dones de oro, incienso y mirra de los reyes magos retrataron a Cristo como el rey ungido del universo.

Mientras que los tres reyes sabios del este aceptaron a Cristo como el rey de todos los reyes, Herodes vio a Jesús como su rival. Por lo tanto, mientras los tres reyes alababan a Dios por el nacimiento de Cristo, Herodes planeaba eliminarlo.

Como la historia bíblica anterior, hay algunos que persiguen a Cristo como Herodes y muchos que se identifican con él de muchas maneras, como los Magos de hoy. Como cristianos, la solemnidad de la Epifanía del Señor nos recuerda que Cristo se manifiesta a nosotros diariamente en el Santísimo Sacramento, y en sus otros dones y bendiciones. Aunque no tengamos oro, el incienso y la mirra como los sabios, pero podemos darle a Cristo nuestros corazones. Al igual que la estrella de Belén, resolvamos comprometernos plenamente con Cristo y mostrárselo a los demás de cualquier manera que podamos. Al agradecerle a Dios por su manifestación hacia nosotros, Jesús quiere que seamos su Epifanía a nuestros vecinos por nuestras obras de misericordia corporales y espirituales.
