Continue onward to **Asakusa Kannon Temple**, one of Tokyo's most colorful and popular. Dating back to 645, it is also the city's oldest. Outside the outer gate, you will stroll through **Nakamise** shopping street.

Take in the views as you visit the world's highest free-standing broadcasting tower. A visit to **Tokyo Skytree** will give you a chance to wander the sky walk, the highest in the world at 450 meters, and enjoy the incredible views.

Take part in a traditional **tea ceremony**, one of the most representative forms of Japanese beauty. Participating in a ceremony is one of the best ways to get a sense of Japanese spirituality.

After lunch visit the Kiyosumi Gardens and Nezu Museum. Nezu Museum showcases calligraphy, painting, sculpture, metalwork and arms, ceramics, lacquer, bamboo crafts, textiles, and archaeological works.
