TRANSFORMED?

² Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of the mind, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect ³ For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think of yourself more highly than you ought to think but to think with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned. Romans 12:2-3

After the Lenten journey with Jesus to the cross, hearing the words of his arrest, denial, death, and crucifixion does it change – or maybe a better word – transformed your relationship with Jesus?

As we entered the 40 days of the Lenten journey, we are to come out transformed followers of Christ. Now that we enter the 50 days after Easter, this is a time to enter a season of making those transformations part of your daily lives.

Remember that Paul's letter to the Romans was to a group of people whom he had not ministered to face-to-face. He writes this letter to them as if they know very little. He is thorough in his writings to the Romans. Paul must have known that selfexamination was something the Romans were lacking. We use the Lenten season to do this self-examination. We use the time to begin to think of our own self discerning for the will of God in our lives. We take a time to move through a non-impaired judgement of ourselves. Now what?

Now that we have seen and heard that God raised Jesus from the dead, we can live into the realization that our sins are forgiven. We are cleansed again and we can stand up straight and live into the very being which God intended us to live. We don't have to live behind a veil of darkness and shame. We can live in the full and complete presence of Jesus, the One who makes us new, again!

A Christmas song, O Come, All Ye Faithful includes a chorus: O come, let us adore him, Christ the Lord.

This chorus still is true in this time of renewal. Our Lord is to be worshipped and adored both as a babe in Bethlehem, and a Savior on Sunday. O come, let us adore him, Christ the Lord.


