Tacoma Youth Symphony Association (TYSA) COVID-19 Protocol

COVID-19 Protocols for Tacoma Youth Symphony Association In-Person Events

Please contact emf@tysamusic.org if your child has traveled outside of the country within 30 days prior to camp.

The COVID-19 crisis requires the Tacoma Youth Symphony Association to adjust our orchestra rehearsals and any other in-person events in the following ways:

- 1. Before leaving the house for any TYSA event parents/guardians will:
- Take child's temperature.
- Ask child if they have any symptoms.
- Ask child if they have been in contact with anyone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- 2. No student, volunteer, or staff member should attend an in-person TYSA event if that person has any of the following possible signs of COVID-19:
- Fever (100.4 or higher) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- 3. Masks and social distancing will be required for all students, volunteers, and staff members in conformance with applicable Washington State and Pierce County guidelines.
- 4. Wind and brass players who participate in-person will be required to use specific masks with an opening for the mouthpiece and as well as bell covers to avoid transmission of the virus. Winds and brass players will be required to empty water on absorbent "puppy pads" during rehearsal.
- 5. Students will bring all required materials to rehearsal and will not share personal items with other members (ie water bottles, phones, pencils, music, rosin, music stands etc.)
- 6. TYSA will provide live stream (Zoom) options for individuals who prefer this option or are unable to attend in person TYSA events.
- 7. Parents/guardians agree to communicate these protocols to their child/ward.
- 8. This protocol is subject to change in conformance with changes in laws, orders, or guidelines from government authorities or health agencies.

This form is due by JUNE 10, 2021.

On Monday, August 2, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. students selected through an audition process outlined below will perform in the Festival Student Recital. The purpose of this recital is to present a varied program and not necessarily showcase the "best" players. These auditions will be held on **Friday, June 25, 2021**. If you would like to audition, you must follow the procedures and meet the deadlines that follow:

- 1. Prepare a serious piece of music (sonata, suite, etc.). Evergreen Music Festival Recital selections should be a complete composition or a complete movement from a composition.
- 2. Call (253) 627-2792 before June 15, 2021 to make a rehearsal and audition appointment.
- 3. All students auditioning must be accompanied at both the audition and the recital Monday evening at the festival unless the piece being performed is written without accompaniment.
- 4. If you are using your own accompanist, please be sure that he or she is able to attend both your audition and the Monday recital should you be selected to perform. It will be your responsibility to notify your accompanist of the results of your audition.
- 5. If you are using our festival accompanist, then you must do the following:
 - a) Provide your accompaniment to the TYSA office by June 10, 2021.
 - b) Mark your tempo marking on your accompaniment.
 - c) Students must be available for **one fifteen minute rehearsal** with the accompanist on the morning of Friday, June 25, 2021.
 - d) Students must call the TYSA office **no later than June 15, 2021** to set up the rehearsal and audition.
 - e) If you are unavailable to rehearse with the festival accompanist then you will not be able to use the festival accompanist.
- 6. If you are unavailable to audition on June 25, 2021 then you will have to forego participating in the recital this year.
- 7. If you are playing a duet, trio, quartet, etc. please fill out one application.

Students selected to perform in the recital will be coached at 12:00 p.m. on Monday at the festival. Accompanists may be asked to attend this coaching session. Notification of those selected to perform will be made a week from the audition.

THE EVERGREEN MUSIC FESTIVAL STUDENT GUIDELINES

Session II

1. Attend all scheduled events

2. Give your best effort to everything you do.

3. NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS ALLOWED AT CAMP, PERIOD!

4. **DRESS CODE**:

- Midriff must be completely covered (standing or sitting)
- Undergarments must be concealed by outerwear
- Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than your fingertips at your side when standing
- No revealing clothing (low-cut, backless, or strapless)
- No clothing that carries violent, vulgar, profane, or offensive message or hat that refers to the use of alcohol, tobacco or drugs
- 5. You are to bring a sack lunch including a beverage with you each day. You will be allowed in designated areas during lunch/free time. You will NOT be permitted to go to any venues in the area.
- 6. Just a reminder that video games, lasers, computers, skateboards, rollerblades, skates, and water propelling devices (like squirt guns or water balloons) are prohibited at this camp.
- 7. Cell phones can be used only during free time or it will be confiscated.
- 8. Do not worry about your placement here in orchestra, chamber groups, or theory classes.
- 9. Encourage others and try to be their friend. Create a social atmosphere and gain new and valuable friends by including everyone. Each person has a unique quality to contribute.
- 10. Clean up after yourself and others.
- 11. You agree to follow all these guidelines by signing the consent form.
