Richard A. Rinn, Attorney at Law, 52, died Wednesday, Nov. 7, 2007 at his home in Marlette.

Mr. Rinn has lived in Marlette for 22 years and was previously from Carsonville. He was born Dec. 18, 1954 in Sandusky, son to Alexander and Esmarilda (Smith) Rinn.

He graduated from Carsonville Port Sanilac High School in 1973 as Class Valedictorian. He received his bachelor's degree from Central Michigan University in 1979 with honors and then went on to receive his Juris Doctorate Degree from Wayne State University Law School in 1983 with honors.
