#### Radio Station News

The radio ministry continues as a vibrant and important mission of Shawnee Presbyterian Church!

Session met with Vince Della Fera and Cathy Klingler of the Radio Committee at Session's meeting on October 18<sup>th</sup> to review current status, needs and plans for the future.

The committee reported that at the end of September our radio station successfully participated in the FCC EAS test, an important technical and licensing accomplishment.

To improve the efficiency of programming and format changes on the station, the committee is exploring options to make changes to programming via internet connections between the studio computer and the transmission computer.

Plans to link our radio station to our website were explored but, alas, require an ongoing expense for a duplicate set of annual music licensing fees. For now, we will stay a "terrestrial" station.
