DESCRIPTION: High quality Staghorn all-purpose bow. Bengé riser. Large handle with full thumb rest. This is a substantial bow that is a superior shooter. The upper back limb has been re-stained. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. There were a few drilled sight holes which have been filled and are barely visible (see pics on last page). Typical "yellowing" of the limbs. The limbs are a uniform color but may not look so in the pics (it's a camera/glare thing). No chips or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. There are a couple of minor scrapes/dimples on the side of the riser. Decal is in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. Note: The specs were stamped into the side of the riser. It lists the bow as what appears to be 68", but it is 66". Comes with a new string.
