## ORDINANCE NO. <u>2011</u>-6

## ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION DURING PUBLIC MEETINGS

WHEREAS, Section 2.06 of the *Illinois Open Meetings Act* (5 ILCS 120/2.06) was recently amended to provide that, "[a]ny person shall be permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established and recorded by the public body";

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Chapin have always encouraged and permitted individuals to make comments during public meetings; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Chapin deem it advisable to adopt rules relating to the participation of the public in the meetings of the Board of Trustees and the various committees established by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, therefore, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: During the open session portion of all meetings of the Board of Trustees and of committees established by the Board of Trustees, each citizen addressing the Board or committee shall be limited to five (5) minutes, unless authorized to speak longer by a majority vote of the trustees or committee persons then voting. Each citizen shall confine his/her remarks to issues or business relating to or impacting the Village. Before being permitted to address the Board of Trustees or a committee, each citizen shall be required to sign a registration card, to be designed by the Village Clerk, stating his/her name, address, and proposed topic.

**SECTION 2**: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
