Participants must reregister each week for Shabbat-only minyanim. Registration begins Motzei Shabbat.

- Deadline: Thursday, August 20, at 4:30pm for Shabbat-only minyanim on August 21–22.
- FOR INSIDE & OUTSIDE MINYANIM: Please remember to wear a mask when entering and exiting the campus and the entire time that you are on the campus. Please bring your own siddurim, chumashim and taleisim, and follow all of the guidelines that you signed. Thank you.
- Those davening at inside minyanim will receive a guidelines video from Rabbi Baum on your minyan groups WhatsApp. Please watch it.
- **Reregistration for all weekday minyanim is required before Monday.**
- **In addition to the already existing minyanim, there will be a daily inside Shacharit at 6:55am: register for it ASAP.**

YAMIM NORAIM SEATS

- Yamim Noraim Early Bird Registration deadline is Monday, August 24. All obligations to the Shul must be paid in full or addressed before your reservations will be accepted.
- Please note that some of the minyanim are nearing or are at capacity.

- Contact Rabbi Baum directly if you do not plan on attending this year, but would like someone to come blow shofar outside your home, a chazzan to daven part of davening with you outside your home, or access to machzorim before Yom Tov.

• Common Questions:

Q- What makes the length of one minyan longer than another?

A- While exact details will depend on many factors, it is likely that the shorter services will skip more Piyutim and that the chazzan will lead at a somewhat quicker BUT not rushed pace.

Q- Will bathrooms be available at the shul for people who daven at the outside minyanim on the campus?

A- Yes, but only one person at a time will be allowed into each bathroom.

Q- Will there be singing at the minyanim?

A- It is too early to know exactly if, and how much, singing will occur. If allowed, there will likely be more flexibility at the outdoor minyanim.
