

## **PHEASANT RUN HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION POOL RULES/REGULATIONS**

The following rules and regulations have been adopted in an effort to make your use and enjoyment of the pool and surrounding areas as pleasant and safe as possible. We ask that everyone please follow these rules. The lifeguards are there for your protection, please respect them and their authority.

1. Weather permitting the pool will be open from 11AM to 6PM. An open umbrella on the first picnic table inside the gate indicates that the pool is open for use. Homeowners only may use the pool during off-hours providing, they have a buddy at pool-side. Last person out after hours must lock the deadbolt on the bathroom doors.
2. All homeowners and guests must display their pool badge at all times. No one will be allowed in the pool area without a badge. The yellow badge is for owners and the white for guests. Lost badges will cost \$10.00 each for replacing. All homeowners and guests must sign in including badge numbers. The book is located at the lifeguard table. All guests must be accompanied by a homeowner, no exceptions.
3. No child under 5 years of age is permitted in the pool area at any time. Children between 5 and 17 years of age must be accompanied by a homeowner. Children 5-17 years of age are permitted in the pool between 11AM and 3PM every day. No child will be allowed in the pool or pool area after 3PM.
4. Children who are non-swimmers must stay in the shallow end of the pool behind the rope accompanied by an adult. Floatation devices are not permitted beyond the rope. Swimmers who are qualified will be permitted in the 5ft. area. The lifeguard will check as to their swimming ability.
5. All swimmers must use the outdoor shower before entering the pool. No soap or shampoo allowed in pool area. No one in diapers is allowed in the pool.
6. No diving or jumping. No beach balls, ball throwing, horseplay or running. Shoes, toys or floatation devices are not allowed to be left at pool side.
7. There are enough chairs and lounges for everyone, please do not reserve seats or tables in advance by placing garments etc. on them. Do not place towels or garments on the fence. Take pride in the appearance of our pool and surrounding areas.
8. Snack food is allowed in the pool area. Picnic tables are available outside of the fence for dining. Plastic, paper or aluminum containers are allowed within the pool area for your drinks. Absolutely no glass is permitted in the pool area. Trash cans are available; keep the area clean.
9. The clubhouse is off-limits to people in wet bathing suits or bare feet. There is access to the rest rooms from the pool area. The rest rooms are not to be used as changing rooms.
10. The lifeguards are the sole authority at the pool and are authorized to request anyone violating these rules to leave the pool area.
11. These are the Pheasant Run Rules/Regulations. Also shown is a portion of the New Jersey State Sanitary Code Public Recreational Bathing Rules for swimming pools, wading pools, hot tubs and spas.

All special functions at the pool must be approved by the Pheasant Run Board of Trustees
