

Village of Newark Receives Grant for Wastewater Treatment Plant Disinfection Study

The Village of Newark is pleased to announce the receipt of a \$30,000 grant from the Wastewater Infrastructure Engineering Planning Grant Program through the New York Clean Water State Revolving Fund.

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has new requirements involving disinfection of sewage treatment plant effluent. The Village will use the grant funding, provided by the DEC and the Environmental Facilities Corporation (EFC), to evaluate the most efficient and cost-effective method for complying with the new mandate.

Mayor Jonathan Taylor stated, “I am delighted that the Village of Newark received this grant. The completed engineering report will help the Village determine the best course of action moving forward in order to meet the new requirement.”
