Whatever you call it, it's important to take your vagina's health seriously. So, if you've had at least three yeast infections (also known as recurrent vulvovaginal candidiasis) in the last year, talk to us about the VIOLET clinical trial. We're testing an investigational drug for women and girls (12+) facing the same challenges as you.

Recurrent yeast infections can be both physically and emotionally uncomfortable to deal with. Because current treatments don't work for everyone, we're looking for women and girls (12+) to help us test a promising investigational drug. To qualify for the VIOLET clinical trial, you must have had at least three yeast infections in the last year.

Importantly:

- ▶ At least one infection must have been confirmed by laboratory/diagnostic test
- ▶ You must have an active infection during your first visit to the study clinic

There are other qualification requirements as well and these will be checked during a screening visit. Women and girls who qualify for the trial will first take 3 doses of fluconazole (a standard yeast infection treatment). If the infection doesn't go away, their time in the trial will end. If it does go away, they'll continue in the trial and be randomly (by chance) assigned to one of 2 groups:

- ▶ Group 1 will take pills containing the investigational drug for the next 12 weeks
- ▶ Group 2 will take pills containing a placebo (which contains no medication) for the next 12 weeks

Neither participants nor the clinic team will know who is assigned to which group. After the 12 weeks, participants' health will be monitored for another 36 weeks. **Please note that all participants will be given fluconazole if an acute infection occurs at any time during the trial.** Also, trial-related drugs and assessments will be provided at no cost. Health insurance is not required to participate.
