Recommendation regarding Jeff Rattiner and his Financial Planning Crash Course for the CFP exam.

I worked with several organizations over the course of three years in preparation for the CFP exam, The American College, The College for Financial Planning and Kaplan. All of which provided a basic and general assertions and statements on what to know for the CFP exam. After taking several practice exams provided by these institutions, I was failing to meet the standard passing scores from the comprehensive exams to achieve a passing score or what was stated as needed to pass the CFP exam.

I signed up for and took Jeff Rattiner's Financial Planning Crash Course in October of 2011 in preparation for the November 2011 exam. Jeff taught directly to the test topics and questions that were on the test material and dramatically improved my scores on the comprehensive exams I used to prepare for the November 2011 exam. He very thorough and resourceful at working through all the test material and spends extra time on topics you need to know and tells you what not to know. He does not waste time and manages the classroom very well and keeps the program on task.
