Team **SURVIVOR** League 2020 Rules & Regs

ORGANIZATION & MANAGEMENT: The Team **SURVIVOR** League 2020 is operated and managed by Beaver-Vu Bowl, 1238 N. Fairfield Rd. Beavercreek, OH 45432. 937.426.6771. Greg Coulles, greg@daytonbowling.com. 937.602.1475.

DATES: This is a Spring/Summer League that will bowl on Tuesdays at Beaver-Vu Bowl with check-in starting at 6:45 PM, bowling starting at 7:00 PM for eleven (11) weeks beginning on April 28, 2020 and ending on July 7, 2020. The eleventh week (July 7th, 2020) will be a "position" round operated in classic league style.

ELIGIBILITY: Any Ohio high school may enter teams in this league. Multiple teams per school are allowed. Team membership is open to any student currently in grades 8-12 (classes of 2020-2024). The school team may consist of all boys, all girls, or a mix of boys/girls. A team must have a minimum of five (5) and may have a maximum of eight (8) bowlers listed on a team roster. No fewer than 5 team bowlers must be present each week to compete.

FORMAT: The format for the 1st 10 weeks will consist of two (2) team games and four (4) Baker games. The 11th week "Position Round" will consist of 10 Baker games. All scoring will be on an actual (scratch) basis.

PRE-BOWLING: A complete team will be allowed to "pre-bowl" for a week. The team captain must reserve lanes for this purpose with Beaver-Vu Bowl. Individuals cannot pre-bowl. **Post-bowling will not be allowed**.

LANE PATTERNS: The lane patterns selected for this league will be lane patterns used at prominent independent, conference, and OHSAA Ohio high school tournaments giving school teams the opportunity to have summer practice on in-season lane patterns. Multiple patterns will be used during the league season (TBA). A list of the pattern to be applied each week will be available (TBA). The lane pattern graph will be available for viewing in the league office each week.

FINANCIALS: The cost to bowl for each **team** is \$90.00 a week (\$18.00 per bowler paid by the bowler). Here is the breakdown of the weekly **team** cost: A. Lineage: \$61.75 (\$3.25 per game, 19 games). B. Team and individual bowler SMART Scholarships: \$13.25. C. Rebate to school Athletic Department or school bowling club: \$15.00.

SCHOLARSHIPS: USBC SMART Scholarships will be awarded to bowlers on the top three (3) teams in the league based on their league standing at the conclusion of the league. The team scholarships will be divided among team members based on number of weeks each bowler participated. In addition, the following individual scholarships will be awarded based on no fewer than sixteen (16) regular games: high boys average, high girls average, high boys series, high girls series, high boys game, and high girls game. The amount of these scholarships will be based on the scholarship funds collected as described above. 100% of all collected scholarship funds will be awarded. In order to be a recipient of a USBC SMART scholarship, the individual bowler must have a USBC membership which is available for purchase from the USBC for \$4.00 (basic membership). *Beaver-Vu Bowl will add up to \$1,000.00 to the SMART scholarship awards in this league (minimum of 10 participating teams, less if fewer).*

SCHOOL REBATES: As a participation incentive, high school coaches are asked to organize their school team bowlers to participate in this league. While coaches are not required to be present each week for this off-season league, coaches are welcome and encouraged to attend and coach their bowlers. The rebates to the school Athletic Department or school bowling club are offered to provide addition revenue for your school bowling program to offset school team costs during the high school season. NOTE: School rebates will only be issued to schools in which a full team participated for all eleven (11) weeks of the season. Rebates to schools for teams that did not participate all 11 weeks of the season will not be issued. Schools with multiple teams that meet this requirement will receive the rebate for each team entered.



Why the Team SURVIVOR League?

KEEP THEM BOWLING!: "Coaches and parents know that high school team bowlers who do not maintain / improve their skills in the off-season suffer an in-season competitive disadvantage with team bowlers who improve their skills with off-season participation and skills development. The skills of high school bowlers who put their equipment in the closet at the end of February and don't pull it out until November do not and cannot improve.

The purpose of this summer league is to "keep them bowling" during the off-season in a competitive and fun environment working on their game to strengthen their individual skills to better contribute to their high school team during the high school season."

<u>Points of Emphasis</u>

- 1. Skill maintenance and improvement. Coaches invited!
- 2. Off-season team bonding.
- 3. Off-season experience on in-season high school lane patterns.
- 4. College Scholarships for athletes.
- 5. Additional revenue for school bowling programs.
