THE VOICE OF GOD

Recently someone asked about hearing the voice of God. How do we know it is He who is speaking to us?

There are three voices – God's, our own and the devil's.

God reveals His secrets to His "proclaimers". (Amos 3:7) When we are born by the Spirit of God we cannot help but to tell what He has done for us. God promises that His word will achieve the purpose for which He sent it. (Isaiah 55:11) God speaks to those who seek His will and do it.

When we commit to this relationship we know for absolutely certain that we hear God's voice when He speaks to us. Jesus said "my sheep listen to my voice; I know them and they follow me." (John 10:27) Because Jesus has said this we know that He will make His will known, but the Holy Spirit is the one who knows the mind of God (1 Corinthians 2:9-11) so we need to be filled with the Spirit continuously. (Ephesians 5:18)
