PERSISTENT ORGANIC POLLUTANTS (POP's)

PERSISTENT ORGANIC POLLUTANTS (POP's) such as DIOXINS can be found in both atmospheric pollution and waste ash residues of incinerators.

These can spread widely and last for a long time.

They have a negative impact on the 'HEFF' (HABITATS, ECOSYSTEMS, FLORA AND FAUNA).

They can also have a negative impact on the health of the human population, attacking immune and nervous systems.

There is strong evidence of a higher incidence of cancers in areas around incinerator sites.
