Bible sites come alive as we visit Mt. of Olives, Mt. Zion, and Bethlehem. We will focus on the ministry of Jesus as we visit the area of Galilee.

Itinerary - November 9-18, 2026



Day 1, Monday, Travel from LAX.

Day 2, Tuesday, Arrive in Tel Aviv. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 3, Wednesday, Begin the day with the Garden Tomb. Mount of Olives; from viewpoint, and continue to Pater Noster Church, commemorating the Lord's Prayer, Dominus Fleuit Church, where Jesus wept over the city of Jerusalem, and the Garden of Gethsemane. After lunch, visit Mt. Zion with the Church of St. Peter's in Gallicantu, where the rooster crowed, and see the stone pit where Jesus was held (Caiaphas' Palace). Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 4, Thursday, You will visit the Temple Mount, Dome of the Rock and the Western Wall-Wailing Wall. You will then travel to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. You will also enjoy lunch at the Grotto and have time for shopping. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 5, Friday, Enjoy the day by visiting the Israeli Museum with Model of Jerusalem and the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed. After lunch, walk the Way of the Cross-Via Dolorosa, through the Old City streets, ending in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 6, Saturday, Begin the day by driving south along the Dead Sea to visit the fortress of Masada, taking a cable car to the top. This site is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Continuing to Ein Gedi; the encounter between David and Saul. After lunch, you will have the opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 7, Sunday, Check out of the hotel. You will then drive north through the Jordan Valley, stopping at Beit She'an, where King Saul's head was hung on the city gate. This city was also known as Scythopolis during the Greek era. Continue to Nazareth and visit the Church of the Annunciation. Overnight in the Galilee area.

Day 8, Monday, Sea of Galilee, including Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha, the place of Jesus' miracle of the Multiplication of the Fish and Loaves, Primacy of Peter, Capernaum: known as "Jesus' hometown." You will take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. You will also have a St. Peter's fish lunch. End the day at the Jordan River; Yardenit. Overnight in the Galilee area.

Day 9, Tuesday, Check out of the hotel. Drive to Caesarea Maritima for a visit. Drive to Tel Aviv and Joppa for a walk through various areas. You will then have a farewell dinner. Possible overnight in Tel Aviv or overnight flight back home.

Day 10, Wednesday, Arrive back to the U.S.
