Navajo Canyon members have worked hard to support the goals and objectives of Carl DeMaio's Reform California. This past month we have folded and stuffed 2500-3000 envelopes on subjects like stopping the Mileage Tax and alerting voters about the upcoming ballot initiative to help taxpayers.

Over 90 percent of the CA state budget is funded with revenues from taxes so this makes raising taxes imperative for Democrats. .

Carl DeMaio and Reform California are leading the campaign to block any more tax hikes by passing a constitutional amendment: The California Taxpayer Protection Initiative.

- Requires a public vote on ALL state tax hikes
- Requires that tax hikes achieve a two-thirds voter approval to pass – not a simple majority.
- Ends the ability of politicians to put deceptive titles on the ballot that fail to disclose a measure contains a hidden tax hike.
- Tightens the definition of a “tax” to eliminate the ability of politicians to call something a mere “fee” to avoid voter approval.

When our volunteers work to get this information into the hands of voters across the state, it greatly increases our chances of passing the initiative.

If we can force the Mileage Tax to a vote, then knowing about this plan ahead of time is helpful. You can't be against something if you don't know about it.

In March we sent 80 postcards to the Mayor of San Diego condemning the passage of the Protect Act that will inadvertently legalize prostitution and stop the police from protecting citizens by asking potential bad actors or registered sex offenders what they are doing hanging around a playground or park near little children or being masked up in front of a liquor store at midnight with an unlicensed car left running.

The mayor doesn't seem to realize that the police notice behavior, not skin color when they stop a car from driving without headlights on the freeway at night.

Police Officers, Teachers, Store Managers and others that deal with large numbers of people, ask questions based on behavior. The mayor and the San Diego City Council feel only the active commission of a crime is grounds for asking questions. Prior to a kidnapping or the trafficking of young teens or in the case of the El Cajon motel occupants that were taking young girls against their will for sex, if the Protect Act was law, the police in San Diego would not be allowed to ask any questions of these men until after a crime had been committed. Thousands of criminals are being released from prison here in California and at the same time they are being released, the Mayor of San Diego and the City Council are making new laws to protect bad behavior.

Go to reformcalifornia.org/petitions to sign the petitions and read up on what you can do to help stop more taxes, stop the banning of gas stoves and now stopping the Democrats from totally canceling all your health insurance and forcing you into all government insurance.

"It is not the critic who counts; not the man who points out how the strong man stumbles, or where the doer of deeds could have done them better.


