

Questions:

- 1) Looking at Genesis chapter one, we read about Creation in all its glory. Do you believe that God created everything? Why or why not?
- 2) Knowing that "Creation speaks to a Creator," as is discussed in Romans one, why do you suppose that many people still do not believe? What reasons are there to doubt, and what reasons are there to believe?
- 3) Looking at the final reading we had from the Gospel of Matthew, what place does the resurrection story play as we talk about creation? Why is Jesus rising from the dead important in our reading of Genesis?

Memory Verse: Romans 1:20 "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse."

Weekly Challenge: As you leave here this week, try to see hints of the Creator in the creation. Notice how things in creation work and speak to the Lord's existence.

The Councils of both Kasson and Pleasant Corners Churches have done some research and have agreed on a system that is similar to "The Beaver System" which will be contracted to Innovated Basements costing approximately \$14,000. Of this amount, the Kasson church will be responsible for about \$10,000.
