Notice of Adoption of Amendment to the Hope Township Zoning Ordinance**

TO: THE RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE HOPE TOWNSHIP,
BARRY COUNTY, MICHIGAN, AND ANY OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at its special meeting on Monday, February 24th, 2020 at 6:30PM at the Hope Township Hall, 5463 S M-43 Hwy, the Hope Township Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance #92, amendment to the Zoning Ordinance.

The adopted amendment modified Section 4.2(F)(2) as it pertains to the reclamation and phasing of mining operations. The amendment requires the Planning Commission to determine the amount of a mining operation site that may be open at any time when reviewing as a special exception use.

These amendments to the Township Zoning Ordinance were adopted after the Planning Commission held a public hearing and recommended approval of the amendment to the Township Board on February 20th, 2020. A copy of the Zoning Ordinance and the amendment is available for review at the Hope Township Office during regular business hours 9:00 a.m. through noon and 1:15 p.m. through 3:00 p.m. on Wednesdays.

The amendment will become effective eight days after the date of this published notice pursuant to the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act, as amended.
