The Stickman Constellation Puzzlechest



This Stickman Constellation Puzzle Chest is a oneof-a-kind commission piece. Crafted from leopardwood, walnut and amboyna burl, it features intricate inlays and hand carved wooden claw fee. This was produced as a wedding gift, and two separate constellations inlays on reciprocal sides of its lid reflect the zodiacs for the bride and groom.

When golden spheres are placed upon the removable top of this chest, they quickly snap into place magnetically. One drawer will only unlock as these spheres line up with the inlay on the lid. The lid can then be flipped over, revealing a second constellational configuration that must be achieved to access a second locked drawer.

The internal mechanics that position the golden spheres are manipulated by pushing in various cube drawers within this chest. There are 16 individual cube drawers, each of which have decorative mechanical inlays that engage and turn internal wooden gears as they are pressed in. Each drawer is also a unique puzzle in and of itself; and each must be solved to retrieve a necessary mechanical pieces required to solve the constellation.



This is an most complex puzzle and requiring hundreds of moves to complete. Determining a strategy to solving it is half of the battle.
