Meeting of the DeKalb County Commission

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance then led the group in prayer followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the agenda and also approve the minutes for the January 28, 2019 meeting. East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the second. Motion carried

Melissa reported that water had entered the building over the weekend from the melting snow. It was determined that bids to install a pitch roof will be reviewed on Monday the 11th of February. After approval of language the bid notices will be mailed out to vendors as well as published in the local paper. Other bids to review that day will be mowing, rock and tubes. All bids will be opened on March 4th.

Northwest Workforce Development Board is hosting a new Presiding Commissioner training on February 15th.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll received a an email from Cindy Whitten, Wind Turbine Team Manager with the Air Traffic Obstruction Group, FAA whom provided information about an FAA website where he can gather information on the procedure to change the lighting on wind turbines. Kyle will report back to the Commission after he reviews the website.

Deputy Sheriff Kasey Keesaman in conjunction with Emergency Management held an active shooter training on Friday the 1st of February for all employees and Office Holders. All that attended the training felt it was very informative and appreciate Kasey taking the day to do this presentation. These trainings that are held will help DeKalb County in attaining grant funds that will help with items needed by emergency management.

Sheriff Andy Clark met with the Commission and gave them a document that had reports and calls his office had taken in the past year. Also discussed was SRO's, vehicles and other issues around the County. The Commission appreciates these reports and Andy keeping them posted on what is going on around the County.

Road & Bridge Supervisor Bill Gray met with the Commission to inform them that the bridge inspections that he had been doing with MODOT are now complete. Austin Hibler will present the report to the Commission at a later date but as of now the bridges in the county look good. Roads were discussed as was Bayfield Rd in Clarksdale and the need to get the concrete dug up. The rock would have to be supplied by the Township if the concrete is torn up. Kyle W. requested a Township meeting as soon as the April election is over to discuss roads, rock, brush and other concerns around the County. It would be during that time that Melissa could give a presentation for those newly elected board members on the process of setting their tax levies and whatever else they might need help with.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee making the second. Motion carried.

With no other business before the Commission they adjourned. The next meeting of the Commission will be February 11th at 9 a.m.
