# God Hears and Answers Prayer - Part Two By Wade Anderson

I've already shared that when there is a prayer request that the praise report is already on its way. From this point forward you will read the praise report that the Holy Spirit has laid upon my heart to share with all of you in resulting from the prayer request Michelle had put in the newsletter several months ago. As you can see, the Holy Spirit had some ground work to lay prior to this portion of the article. The Scriptural foundation is important for this testimony. It's a testimony to the promise of physical healing being fulfilled in me through what Jesus **has already done** for us all. God has completely restored my health after being diagnosed with prostate cancer. The truth is Jesus paid the price for my healing over 2,000 years ago so that I could use my faith to activate His promises and NOW receive my healing. God's promises do not have an expiration date! Praise God!!

I have an awesome doctor that keeps an amazing eye on my internal parts. Over a six month span early on in 2013, he had been watching my blood and noticed that my PSA levels (something in the blood) were on the rise so he sent me to a Urologist. The Urologist did several biopsies and in November 2013, I was diagnosed with prostate cancer. I still remember how I felt the day that I set in his office. As we sat there he began to give me the results of the biopsy and when he said the word 'cancer' it was as though everything after that was muffled and I was entering a long black tunnel. I stopped him and said, "Wait a second, did you just say I have cancer?" When he answered, "Yes," I told him, "Hang on, give me just a second to process this." Deep inside I could feel as the fear was attempting to have me build on all sorts of emotions. Early on in our visits I had already made it known to my Urologist about my faith in Christ Jesus. In doing so he began to speak openly and shared of his faith in Jesus as well. As I gathered my thoughts and emotions I looked at him and told him, "You couldn't have told me this at a better time. I'll be at a Faith Explosion conference being held at our church for the next four days." Smiling he then went on to explain the various options available and the steps we would be taking in each of them. One of which included 'if' I were to chose to do nothing allowing the 'cancer' to run its course to see what sort of yardage I might finish with. To me that would be giving up. Honestly folks he knew the yardage I had my faith in and it was not settling for anything short of a 'touchdown' AND the 'field goal'. But being in the medical field he felt he had to let me know the different avenues available.

In my heart I knew that 'cancer', like every other sickness and disease, had already been defeated and it had to bow to the name of Jesus. Even after that last sentence I've got to be completely transparent and tell you, "Almost instantly tons of thoughts began the attempt of clouding my vision." It wasn't my heart that I had issues with it was my mind. My mind kept rolling over and over all the different people I had known that had had 'cancer'. Thoughts like, "What were the results they ended up with?" It was as though every TV commercial or advertisement I had seen on billboards had to do with 'cancer'. Even at the Faith Explosion conference, I was hearing references to the word 'cancer'. Listen closely though, the difference between the two messages I was hearing was that at the conference it was the Spirit of God affirming to me the Imow My shapp and My shapp Imow Me .... " Jesus is coaching us to listen and know His voice. And again in John 10:27 Jesus says, "My shaap listen to My volce; I LATOW them, and they follow Ma." I couldn't allow (that's my part) the two voices to get tangled together. Why? Because only One would tell me the whole TRUTH! It's up to us which voice we listen to. In fact travel back up the page just a few Scriptures. Again Jesus speaking and I believe He is sharing the difference between the two voices, confusion and peace. Here, in John 10:10 (AMP), you listen and decide for yourselves, "The this! comes ONLY in order to steel and kill and destroy. I came that they MAY HAVE and enjoy life, and have It in ABUNDANCE (to the FULL, till it OVERFLOWS)." I don't know about all of you but to me those red letter words don't sound anything like limited yardage. AMEN! I knew that I had to grab hold of my thoughts and shake them, if you will, or else they would be off like a runaway train bound for a derailment. While shaking those 'senses' into alignment with the voice of TRUTH I began to hear in my spirit the VOICE that I stood on, "Their circumstances are not your circumstances, their faith or beliefs may not have been the same as yours. Do you believe what My Word has to say about your healing? Okay then, let's walk THROUGH this together."

As I left the doctor's office I already knew in my spirit that God had prepared my way, Jesus had His hands around me and I would receive a speedy recovery. Something else that was running through my mind was I knew Michelle would be expecting me to call her with the results from the office visit. As I mentioned earlier, we had been praying and believing for different results so I knew this would come as just as much a shock to her as it did to me. But regardless of 'their' diagnosis I also believed that God would show me the way to use whatever circumstances lay ahead of us to reach and bring awareness to someone else somewhere. When I made the call and gave Michelle the results she broke down and began to cry. I knew in my heart I had to quickly reign her in and not allow the same lies that tried to rise up in me to take root in her either. I said, "Stop! Stop crying! We don't have anything to fear. Get it all out now because we are NOT going to cry about this again. There is NO sickness or disease stronger than the Blood of Jesus, that's what we both believe and that's the only thing we're going to focus on is the finished work of Jesus!" Michelle quickly dried it up, we prayed and agreed together on God's promise that, *"He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities, the* 

punishment that brought us peace was on Him, AND BY HIS WOUNDS WE ARE HEALED." (Isaiah 53:5) When we were done praying I made it clear that I was only going to share this diagnosis with a few people. It wasn't that I thought most people wouldn't want to know but the truth was I didn't want all of the negative reactions and comments flying around. I know most people mean well but I wanted faith speaking, Word confessing people to be praying and surround-ing us. Even at that within a few months, I had long time friends calling me to see if I were really dying! NO!!!! SHUT UP!

As we began the next four days at the Faith Explosion conference, I went to pray with my most favorite prayer partner, Pat (many of us referred to her as mom). As I filled Pat in on the doctor's diagnosis she grabbed my hands while looking me in the eyes and smiling like she always did with the love of Jesus radiating from her, she said, "Listen to me! This is no big deal. This is what I want you to confess every day until you believe it and know it deep in the real you, your inner Spirit man, 'I am the righteousness of God, through Christ Jesus, by faith, I believe it AND I receive it in Jesus' name!" From that moment forward I did as the Holy Spirit had guided Pat to direct me to do. As the months of November and December (2013) slipped away and January 2014 rolled in, I not only focused on those promises but as well I began to realize that it wasn't my blood that was running through my veins but now it was the Blood of Jesus! I felt the Holy Spirit impress in me, "Take communion in the mornings, read My healing Scriptures and listen to the CD." I wasn't confused by 'CD' because just a few days before this I was listening to these people playing at yet another conference and a peace filled me then saying, "Buy Charlie and Jill LeBlanc's CD *Simply Worship.*"

In January 2014, the Urologist did the surgery and when he came into the recovery room he let me know that the surgery had gone according to what 'we' both were standing in faith for. I had complete confidence that God was guiding and directing every move of the surgeon and the anesthesiologist's hands. AMEN!? When I arrived in the hospital room the nurses began encouraging me by letting me know, "The sooner you get up and get going the sooner you can go home." That was all I needed to hear. In between witnessing to the nurses, I grabbed the IV bag stand and began to push forward. When I was resting in the bed I covered myself with a beautiful hand knitted blanket sent to me just a couple of days prior by a brother "inmate" from a Federal prison. The blanket had a large cross and the Scripture reference *Matthew 6:33* on it. By the next morning I was doing several laps at a time around the nurses' station. When the doc came in that morning he was blown away to the point that he said, "WOW! You look amazing and the nurses' say, 'Duck's taking up bed space, send him home!"I was ready to go Praise God!

After getting home from the hospital, I began walking in my speedy recovery. After a certain amount of healing time, I had one more part of the process to go through, radiation treatment. The treatment consisted of 5 days a week for 8 weeks, 40 treatments. The Radiologist told me that I could continue to do everything that I normally would be doing in my day. So I did. We added a pad of concrete that now accommodates 3 more vehicles (4 yards of concrete). From the parking area towards the house I dug and laid a 6 foot wide decorative paver sidewalk and sitting area, in two directions. From there I redesigned and rebuilt my flower area all the way to the front door. Are you keeping up with me here? I put an 18 inch high block wall in the other part of the yard and filled one side with 4 ton of dirt. Did I mention that a pal and I wheel barrowed 2 1/2 ton of rock from where the new parking area went in to the backyard? I had stood on God's promises, trusted Him for my healing and even saw it completed from the very beginning of the experience and NOW I was walking it out! Praise Jesus! Let's get back to the treatment office.

OH MY GOSH! God placed the most amazing radiology technicians in my path! I was given the opportunity to witness to ALL of them and even gave my previous testimony (I also let them know they were in the middle of this one). Seeing that I was there for treatment everyday with the same group of men God also opened the door to minister to them. Many of the opportunities were as simple as a smile with positive encouraging words. Each person's appointment was the same time every day. Sometimes we would meet in the lobby, sitting for a brief minute and other times passing each other with a hand shake and a hug while moving in or out of the treatment room. It sort of reminded me of those Willie Coyote and Sheep dog cartoons (Ha! Ha!). Without all the hair in our eyes it was easy to see there was a genuine peace in a few of the men. As we all progressed, men began to complete treatments and 'graduate'. We each received a certificate of completion, got to ring this big brass bell in the lobby AND chose to have our pictures taken with the ladies that encouraged us and stood by our sides. Like I've already said, "This was the last part of 'their' process." NO worries and NO concerns, right? RIGHT!

In the 7th week of the radiation treatment I began to feel a pain in my right groin area. The Radiologist assured me it wasn't from the treatment and he referred me back to the Urologist. The Urologist examined me and then he sent me to yet another specialist where he came to the conclusion that perhaps I had been even more energetic than the first two doctors had anticipated. In other words I was an over achiever. What was the new verdict? I had developed a lateral hernia and needed ANOTHER surgery. Due to the radiation treatments I had just completed there was a waiting process before they would do this new operation. So, in the meantime I went on a 7 or 8 day Salmon fishing trip with one of my brothers up in Oregon. Two days after we arrived home from Oregon the hospital called and said they were ready for me to come have the operation. This puts us at October 1, 2014. Did I just hear someone say, "What happened to your faith

Jesus is just so great, isn't He? Getting to know Him has made all the difference in my relationship with God. You know God is just so amazing ... C.H.

J. just came by with a praise report. I have been working with him off and on. He is very faithful at the 8:30 group and he comes by when he wants to pray or needs an answer to something. Well, he wanted to tell me about something that just happened. He just moved into a cube and his neighbors

saw him reading his Bible, so they asked him if he was a Christian. He was so joyous that he was able to spend 20 or 30 minutes with them answering their questions. Well, God bless (and all your cards are on my wall), ALL things are possible through Christ; I pray we can continue to communicate, it's priceless in here. I promise my appreciation is real, keep me in your prayers, and your card made me realize that not in my time, but His time, and His timing is perfect.

God has opened up the windows of heaven and poured out His blessings with more than we could have dreamed to receive. (*Malachi 3:10*) We have the bike, we're headed on a trip AND the healed and restored person writing this message is me! ALL GLORY TO GOD!! I sure hope you all are picking up what I'm laying down here!

Before I go any further I've got to tell you all that Michelle has always been a rock solid, Word confessing, *Proverbs 31* woman of God. From the day I came out of the Radiologist's office where we prayed and agreed to stand on God's promises, to KILL the root of 'their' diagnosis, she has remained steadfast!! She has NOT backed up for even a second to listen to the liar!

It's been over a year now since the diagnosis. In December 2014, I went to Ohio for a deer hunting trip with two of my brothers for 14 days. No deer, sad face. While I was in Ohio I was blessed to visit and hangout with my oldest daughter, Monica, my two oldest grandsons, Frank and Dylan, as well as Carlos, Monica's fiancé. Before this I hadn't seen all of them for 6 months or more and now we were blessed to love on each other right before Christmas. Blessings! And a BIG happy face! But wait there's more! January 14th-17th, 2015 a brother in Christ, an accountability partner, and I drove 12 hours to an Andrew Wommack Men's conference in Woodland Park Colorado at the base of Pikes Peak. While we were there, we were completely immersed in the Holy Spirit and basked in God's LOVE, along with 893 other men!! POWERFUL! POWERFUL! Do I need to go on? Now let's turn over in the New Testament to 1 Corinthians 1:30-31 (NLT), where Paul is affirming that, "God alone made it possible for you to be IN CHRIST JESUS. For our benefit God made Christ to be wisdom itself. He is the One that made us acceptable to God. He made us pure and holy, and He gave Himself to purchase our freedom. As the Scriptures say, 'The person who wishes to boast should boast ONLY of what the Lord has done.'"

Do you remember earlier where I had mentioned that I hadn't wanted to let but a few people know about the diagnosis? Well, there came a time when I felt the Holy Spirit speak this to my spirit, "There are prayer warriors ready! Don't allow (that's our part) religion to stand in your way of receiving the Grace Revolution Message. Here's what *Titus 2:12* has to say concerning this, *"It* (Grace) *teaches us to say NO to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in THIS present age ..."* 

I'll close with this, "When you pray believe (when you pray) and from that point forward don't back up or give up. Continue to praise God and thank Him for the answered prayer (when you pray) because you are only one prayer away from yours or someone else's MIRACLE!!" We LOVE you all and we appreciate you!
