Rules

1. Entries close July 15, 2017.
2. Substitutes will not be accepted after midnight, August 3, 2016.
3. Entry fee is \$1.00 per head for Open Show breeders and must be paid at the time of entry. Entry fees will not be refunded.
4. All entered animals must be owned by the exhibitor at least 30 days before the Show, **AND MUST BE MARKED WITH PERMANENT PENNSYLVANIA DESIGNATED SCRAPIE EAR TAG.**
5. All animals must be in place by 10:00 A.M., Wednesday, the first day of the Fair, and remain at the Fair Grounds until 5:00 P.M., Sunday, the last day of the Fair. The only exception will be those exhibitors who have permission from the Fair Chairman to attend another Sheep Show. **Violators will automatically forfeit their premiums.**
6. Any number of animals may be entered in a class.
7. Sheep showing clinical signs of contagious, infectious or external parasitic disease including foot rot will NOT be admitted to any show.
8. The flock of origin, including sheep consigned to a show, shall be examined by an accredited veterinarian. The veterinarian must prepare the official health certificate and must state on the health certificate that he examined the entire flock and found no evidence of contagious, infectious or external parasitic disease. The date of examination must also appear on the health certificate. All sheep from other states must be accompanied by an interstate health certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian indicating an examination for health within 30 days.

The purpose of this show is to encourage the production of better fleeces of wool for home spinners and weavers.

Rules:

Wool exhibited must be produced by the exhibitor who must have owned the sheep from the fleece that was shorn

Exhibits are open to both purebred and commercial flocks

White fleeces must be 100% white. Natural Colored Fleeces must be at least 35% colored fiber.

Exhibits will be placed in clear plastic bags

Disqualifications in the wool category may include:

Any fleece not skirted, removing excessive dirt, plant materials, tags, etc.

Showing any paint or tar brand substances

Discolored from excessive moisture, oxidations, or showing effects of cotting
