## \*COOLING UNIT MUST BE DISCONNECTED FROM POWER SOURCES

- 1. Using a Phillips screw driver, remove the two (2) screws holding the control panel to the base.
- 2. Pull the control unit forward removing it from the base.
- 3. Label each wire with tape (white medical). Position your replacement control panel near the original one so that you may start to transfer the wires.
- 4. Use Needle Nose pliers to remove each connector, one by one from the original control board and move it to the replacement control board.
- 5. Before applying power to the cooling unit insert the control panel back in the base of the unit and replace the screws in the panel.
- 6. Connect cooling unit to the power outlet.

(NOTE - This control board is similar to a small home computer and can be effected by unstable power. Power surges and/or electrical storms can cause this control board to malfunction or lose its memory settings. Connecting it to a surge protection device can help protect your control board against various power stability problems.)
