Enrollment of New Employees

New Appointment

If you are a new employee, you may enroll in any available plan, option, and type of enrollment within 60 days after your date of appointment, unless your position is excluded from coverage. If you were employed in a position that was excluded from coverage and then appointed to a position that conveys coverage, you may enroll within 60 days after the change.

USPS City Carrier Associates (CCA)

If you are a CCA who has served 360 days, you have the following options:

- You can choose Self Only coverage in the USPS Noncareer Plan and receive a \$125 contribution toward your premium every two weeks.
- 2. You can choose Self Plus One or Self and Family coverage in the <u>USPS</u>

 <u>Noncareer plan</u> and get 75% of the total premiums paid by the USPS every two weeks.

If you have not completed a 360 day period of service, you have the following options:

- 1. You can choose Self Only coverage in the USPS Noncareer plan and receive a \$125 premium contribution from the USPS every two weeks.
- You can choose Self Plus One or Self and Family coverage in the USPS Noncareer plan, and receive 65% of the total premium paid by the USPS every two weeks.
