Do You REALLY Know Who You Are IN CHRIST JESUS? - Part 1 By Wade Anderson

Let's pray: "Gracious and Almighty heavenly Father I ask Your Holy Spirit to rise up from the pages of Your most Holy Word and quicken all of our spirits with the truth hidden in them for us today. We invite You Holy Spirit to be our teacher, to cut through the religion that has held us captive to wrong believing that has been so deeply entrenched in each of us. I ask that everything that is written here in this message today be washed in the precious Blood of Jesus and only truth remain in our hearts. In Jesus' name, AMEN! AMEN!"

I know that some of the things we cover in these newsletters mess with a lot of peoples religiosity. Meaning, for so many years many of us have been taught by well meaning pastors and leaders that, "If you haven't confessed all of the sin in your life and God comes in the middle of the night, well, unfortunately for you you're going to burn in hell!" And this is just one wrong teaching. Brothers and sisters, that would keep us in a constant state of sin consciousness instead of being focused or conscious of what God has ALREADY provided through the finished work of Jesus! I'll be the first to admit that from one tiny bit of understanding to the next God is always dialing me in to listen more closely to His Holy Spirit's leading. I know it's a little early in to this message, but can I be frank with you right now? Thank you for your excitement and loud "YES", but I really wasn't attempting to get that response due to the fact that I have to be frank anyway. Do you think even for a second that God didn't already know, when Jesus hung on that Cross, that you and I were still going to sin, and sin and sin? Because of His love for us all and knowing the way we would be is exactly why He sent His only Son (*John 3:16*) to be 'the once for ALL sin offering (*Hebrews 10:10*)!' I know some of you will have to chew on this for awhile before you digest it BUT here it goes anyway. Jesus laid His life down not only for those who would believe and receive Him BUT for the WHOLE world, whether some do or not it is still available to EVERYONE!! AND EVERY SINGLE SIN COMMITED BY EVERYONE FOREVER AND EVER HAS ALREADY BEEN PAID FOR IN FULL!!! Grace is NOT a license to sin but it brings awareness for repentance. Grace is provided UNDER THE BLOOD OF JESUS!!!

The Apostle Paul shows us in 2 Corinthians 5:14-15 (Message) that, "Our firm decision is to work from this focused center: One Man died for EVERYONE. That puts EVERYONE in the same boat. He included EVERYONE in His death so that EVERYONE could also be included in His life, a resurrection life, a far better life than people ever lived on their own." I don't believe that I'm going out on a limb when I say that most of our issue is not sin. And if anyone believes that I'm making light of sin that's just pure ignorance. We cannot pick and choose what pieces we wish to believe. We cannot believe this last part of Romans 6:23 (Message), "But God's gift is real life, eternal life, delivered by Jesus, our Master" without noticing the first piece of the Scripture, "Work hard for sin your whole life and your pension is death." Obviously one can see that there is an option available, one of our choosing. So our bigger issue is the lack of faith to believe in the Word of God. What we need is LESS DOUBT! Jesus told his own disciples that it wasn't that they needed more faith. What He said they needed was faith in God and less doubt (Mark 11:22-24). If Jesus said it we would be wise to believe it!! After reading just this paragraph you shouldn't want to run out and sin more but instead it should cause you to reevaluate the commitment you have with God. In fact, these truths should start to ring in your new spirits and cause you to want to sin less and less not more! When a person is truly saved their inner being, their new Spirit will ultimately cause even their flesh to take notice and pay attention. In 2 Corinthians 5:16 Paul, guite simply attempts to tell us (my paraphrase here), "Listen, you have no way of knowing what is going on in the heart of another human being. In fact, it wasn't that long ago you looked at Jesus the same way!" Paul goes from that statement directly into 2 Corinthians 5:17 and says, "Therefore, if anyone is IN CHRIST, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, ALL things have become new."

As you've heard me say before, I too was one of those young lads that was told, "you are going to church" 3 - 4 times a week. Because of their 'taking me' I was saved at an early age ... then saved again ... and again ... and again. This continued on over and over for a few years. This kind of teaching is truly confusing to most seasoned Christians let alone a young person like myself that never truly understood what I could have possibly done that would have made God so mad and angry with me from one week to the next!? My question to myself was always, "Why would the God that is so full of love want to see me crying and belly aching, feeling shame and condemnation, at the altar ALL THE TIME?" With all of the 'encouragement' to be at the altar, sometimes it felt like I was being pushed to confess things I hadn't even thought of or done, yet! That's what the law or religion does towards a person, if it's not pushing you it's pointing out 'your' sin. That lack of true understanding built a wall of total confusion around my heart and in my mind. The Bible tells us all, in 1 Corinthians 14:33 that, "God is not a God of confusion but a God of peace." And then in John 10:10 Jesus clearly tells us, "The thisres surpose is to steel and kill and destroy, by surpose is to aive life in all its fullness." Please believe me when I say, I'm in no way trying to insinuate that those attempting to lead me or teach me in my young Christian walk with the Lord Jesus Christ were of the enemy! No!! In fact, I'm 100% confident that they were teaching us at the level of understanding that most Christians still operate under to this day. So today, receiving a new understanding, I've chosen to take what they planted in me, pull up the religious weeds, sow and water the soil of my heart with the truth of God's Word and allow the Holy Spirit to minister personally to my spirit. I encourage you all to do the same. I realize today that the

enemy was trying to keep me confused so that he could slowly rob me and destroy any of what was sown into me so that I wouldn't even consider all that God had made available for me. And you know what? That worked for about 37 years. Once I totally surrendered my whole self to God in April of 2007 He revealed to me, through these Scriptures in *Isaiah 55:10 -11* (NLT), that He was clearly waiting on me to wake up to this truth. "The rain and the snow come down from the heavens and STAY on the ground to water the earth. They cause the grain to grow, producing seed for the farmer and bread for the hungry. It is the same with My Word. I sent it out, and it produces fruit always. It WILL accomplish ALL I want it to, and WILL prosper everywhere I send it."

Looking back on it all today it isn't hard for me to see that long before I turned 14 years old. I was losing interest in my walk with a God. I was led to believe that even though God was a loving God, one wrong move and He would become mad and angry with me. And even though I'd been raised with 'some' wrong believing, 'subconsciously', I had been given a roadmap back to where I belonged. This is as well the story found in Luke 15:11-32. This young man had grown up in a family that loved God and loved him but at some point he became deceived through the way he was perceiving the world from his 'comfortable' surroundings, and he too left to explore the world. Sound familiar? Many of us are fortunate, like the young man in this story, that when we "came to our senses" we were able to pull out that roadmap and wander our way back home. If we would honestly and selflessly admit and be aware, stopping to look around, we'd be able to see that MANY, MANY of those in our very midst have never heard of Jesus let alone received the memo that He loves them! This would also indicate that we are letting them die and go to hell on our watch without even sharing Jesus with them! Why?! The Prodigal son story is the story in our own lives; that God loves us and will always take us back! This in NO way means that we should take advantage of God's grace and mercy right down to our last breath. You know why? Because we don't know exactly when that will be. Wouldn't that be like playing Russian roulette? This roadmap says, "After you have beat yourselves up over and over again attempting to fit in somewhere you weren't meant to be you can always turn and come the opposite direction. Look up, and see that I am ALWAYS standing here, not with condemnation and a whip but with opened arms and a big smile on My face motioning you to come home and rest IN ME."

Over the years of learning through my own situations I've come to understand that, it was my own actions that landed me in ALL the predicaments I found myself in. It was either my choice to listen and follow someone else's direction or my own decisions but either way it was still my choice! And the only way I've learned to move forward out of thinking that it was always someone else's fault, was to own up to my own actions, accept my responsibility, ask for God's help and with His help move forward.

I said that in order to say this. The God we serve DOES NOT put us in prison or predicaments to teach us something! NO!!! It's our own actions that land us in situations that begin to open our eyes. Through such situations it's then that God can seize the opportunity and use it to get our attention. God never sent us out into the world to be tested or tempted! It was and always is our own fleshly desires that lead us astray. Let me say right here that when you 'feel' like you are going through some sort of test or trial, "DON'T STOP AND CAMP THERE!" And don't say that it is from God! God doesn't throw opposition in front of us to see if we are strong or not! But instead look at opposition as an opportunity to grow stronger. Why else would our enemy, the devil, throw things in our way UNLESS he seen that God had great things just ahead of us to do?! I heard someone say the other day that, "If you are not running into opposition from the enemy, chance could be that you're both headed in the same direction." People we are NOT strong enough on our own to walk around in this corrupt world without the life giving Spirit of God speaking to us and helping us with His strength! Sure there may be some people that at first glance seem to be happy, content and well put together and not serving God. But when we invest the time in getting to know them at a deeper level we begin to see that some of them are covering up all sorts of baggage. Others, too, have been deeply cut and scarred and hardened by religious people's 'opinion' of who they should be and what they should look like in God's eyes. Wait a second, isn't the 'cleaning us up' part the Holy Spirit's job?!

Obviously, as we begin to open the Bible and read we see that there is an Old Testament and a New Testament, right? The Old Testament is the old covenant, Law and the wrath of God pouring out everywhere. The old covenant was full of do good get good, do bad get bad. In a general sense, we all have experienced this principle and know that for the most part things do work that way. But the teaching was that when you did good for or to God He would be good to you. There was no way you could follow every letter of the Law so that meant that God was angry and mad at you and may even pour His wrath out on you even to the point of your death. The old covenant produced a mentality where people were always trying to do something to get something. People were doing the best 'they' could ever do in order not to receive the judgment of God upon themselves. The Law was so harsh that NO one ever stood a chance of fulfilling all of its requirements. But listen closely, the Law wasn't set in place to cause us to trip and fall so that God could be mad and angry. Instead, the Law was put in front of us to show us that we ALL so desperately need help! Someone that can and will help us to accomplish all we'd never be able to accomplish without Him! AMEN?! And that leads us directly into the New Testament.

When we get to the New Testament we begin to see that something has changed. Almost instantly we begin to see that ... continued on page 9

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Foot's Bible Study Rotes

2 Kings 17:1-19:37

Sometimes it is difficult and painful to follow God, but consider the alternative. You can live for God or die for yourself. Determine to be God's person and do what He says regardless of the cost. What God thinks of you is infinitely more important than what those around you think. See *Romans* 12:1 and 1 John 2:15-17. (17:7-17)

We must be careful that aids to our worship don't become objects of worship themselves. Most objects are not made to be idols - they become idols by the way people use them. (18:4)

Prayer should be our first response in any crisis. Don't wait until things are hopeless. Pray daily for His guidance. Our problems are God's opportunities. (19:1-7)

We should not be afraid to approach God with our prayers, but we must come to Him with respect for who He is and what He can do. (19:15-19)

Acts 20:1-21:17

The way of the believer is not an easy road ... being a Christian does not solve or remove all problems. Paul served humbly and "with tears", but he never quit, never gave up. The message of salvation was so important that he never missed an opportunity to share it. And although he preached his message in different ways to different audiences, the message remained the same ... "Turn away from sin and turn to Christ by faith." The Christian life will have its rough times, its tears, its sorrows, as well as its joys, but we should always be ready to tell others what good things God has done for us. His blessings far outweigh life's difficulties. (20:18-21)

Paul knew he would be imprisoned in Jerusalem. Although his friends pleaded with him not to go there, he knew that he had to because God wanted him to. No one enjoys pain, but a faithful disciple wants above all else to please God. Our desire to please God should overshadow our desire to avoid hardship and suffering. When we really want to do God's will, we must accept all that comes with it - even the pain. Then we can say with Paul's companions, "The will of the Lord be done." (21:13-14)

Psalm 148:1-149:9

All creation is like a majestic symphony or a great choir composed of many harmonious parts that together offer up songs of praise to the Lord. Each part (independent, yet part of the whole) is caught up and carried along in swelling tides of praise. This is a picture of how we believers should praise God - individually, yet as part of the great choir of believers world-wide. Are you singing your part well in the world-wide choir of praise? (148:5-14)

Although the Bible invites us to praise God, we often aren't sure how to go about it. Here, several ways are suggested ... by singing, dancing, or playing musical instruments. God enjoys His people, and we should enjoy praising Him. (149:3-5)

Proverbs 18:6-8

These Proverbs remind us that a fool's mouth is his/her downfall. If we allow foolish words to spew from our mouth's, we can only expect contention and destruction as a response. Think about the words you choose to use. (18:6-7)

It is as hard to refuse to listen to gossip as it is to turn down a delicious dessert. Taking just one morsel of either one creates a taste for more. You can resist rumors the same way a determined dieter resists candy - never even open the box. If you don't nibble on the first bite of gossip, you can't take the second or third. (18:8)

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Overcomer's Testimonies

I'm writing to you with a great and awesome praise report for our Lord who hears our prayers and delivers. On Thursday, December 17th, I was called into the CPO office where I was told that my probation revocation hearing was scheduled for January 6, 2016. I then wrote my wife and prepared for that day, but God had other plans.

My wife had sought out a lawyer and my parents sent my wife a \$3500 check for the non-refundable retainer. My folks paid extra so that it would be delivered Friday morning, so that my wife could pay the lawyer that afternoon, but God had other plans.

For those last 30 days, I was desperately holding on to my faith and struggling to serve in the dark, because I was blind. Blind to the plans that God had for me, blind to the truth that He was always there. In my blindness and despair, I told God that I hated Him, and He in return loved me more. On that Thursday, I had peace as I focused on the phrase in the Bible that was running in my mind, "Sanctify the Lord God in your hearts," (1 Peter 3:15) I did and I had peace. I was ready to face the parole board and accept whatever decision they passed down, but God has other plans.

On Friday, December 18th, God showed up in a big and awesome way, there and then He became real for me. I was sitting on my bunk when 2 guards came rushing in with trash bags. They said, "Hurry, and put all your property in the bags." They were rushing me to hurry because of count. I had no idea what was going on. Was I being moved to another unit or did I do something wrong and I was being sent to lockdown? I had no idea.

The guards took me to intake and took my belongings to the property room. A few minutes later the guards took me to medical. They jumped the line to get me processed through medical quickly. Then a guard took me aside and asked if I knew what was going on. I said, "I'm being rolled up, and sent to another yard." All I could think was this is a big mess. I need to get ready for the parole board, not moving to a new unit with a new address. This was going to make contacting my wife harder. This couldn't have come at a worse time.

The guard said, "No, you're leaving." I said, "Leaving, to where?" He said, "You don't understand, you're getting out of prison today, Right now!" I looked him in the eyes and said, "You're lying." He just smiled and said, "No, it's true." They gave me release clothing, rushed me on a special transport to get my picture and ID. There were lots of guards running around, rushing to process me out. They took me to the parole office, where the parole supervisor, who violated me just a month before, told me that new information had come to light and they decided to believe me, that I did not tamper with the GPS device, and that they were going to give me another chance. They squashed the violation. It was gone, like it never happened.

"The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, like the rivers of water, He turns it wherever He wishes." (Proverbs 21:1) If the king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, so is the parole supervisor, so is the warden, and captain and guards of DOC. It does not matter if they serve Christ or not, when the Spirit of God moves all must bow down before Him. All must follow the will of the Lord God, my Lord God, our Lord God, forever and ever, amen!!

The first time I was released was according to the will of the courts. My release day was scheduled by them and they carried out their plan. The second time I was released, it was according to the will of God, according to His schedule and His plan. He showed up and said, "Get My child out of prison now!"

I don't know all of why this happened, but I know this, that the way I got out of prison is a testament to the fact that HE IS THE LORD GOD! No one knows His ways, no one gives Him counsel. His will is done, and there is none like Him, not on Earth or in all the heavens. HE IS THE LORD GOD! All the inmates, all the guards, all the parole officers saw it with their own eyes. This Lord, this God is a Deliverer. "Is My hand shortened at all that it cannot redeem? Or have I no power to deliver?" (Isaiah 50:2b)

What kind of God is this, that He would do this for someone like me? One I will serve always. I'm not sure what's going to happen to me, what my future holds, but I no longer care. Now God is real to me. Not just a prayer, not just a hope, but an active, real, living God that is with me and for me.

Thank you so much for all your prayers and I hope this praise report will start your new year off with great joy in your hearts and with praise and thanks to God on your lips, for He has heard you and He has answered with a big gigantic, "Yes!" A World Brimming With Temptation By Steve Arterburn

"Be careful! Watch out for attacks from the Devil, your great enemy. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for some victim to devour. Take a firm stand against him, and be strong in your faith." - 1 Peter 5:8-9

It's inevitable: today you will be tempted by somebody or something in fact, you will probably be tempted on countless occasions. Why? Because you live in a world that's filled to the brim with temptations and addictions that are intended to lead you far, far away from God.

Here in the 21st century, temptations are now completely and thoroughly woven into the fabric of everyday life. Seductive images are everywhere; subtle messages tell you that it's okay to sin "just a little"; and to make matters even worse, society doesn't just seem to endorse godlessness, it actually seems to reward it. Society spews forth a wide range of messages, all of which imply that it's okay to rebel against God. These messages, of course, are extremely dangerous and completely untrue.

How can you stand up against society's tidal wave of temptations? By learning to direct your thoughts and your eyes toward things that are pleasing to God . . . and by relying upon Him to help you stay focused on things that are "whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable" (Philippians 4:8). And here's the good news: the Creator has promised (not implied, not suggested, not insinuated-He has promised!) that with His help, you can resist every single temptation that confronts you.

Once you firmly decide to stand up to temptation, you are never alone. God is always with you, and if you do your part, He will do His part. But what, precisely, is your part? A good starting point is simply learning how to recognize the subtle temptations that surround you. The images of immorality are ubiquitous, and they're intended to hijack your mind, your heart, your pocketbook, your life, and your soul. Don't let them do it.

Ask yourself these important questions: What images, people, or places are you likely to encounter today that might encourage you to think impure thoughts? And how will you prepare yourself to respond to these temptations?
