

Daycare Waiting List Procedures

We strongly encourage anyone who thinks their child may in the future need a space in our Daycare to fill out an application and put their child's name on the waiting list. Most families put their child's name on our waiting list many years in advance, often right after birth.

To apply for subsidy, contact the City of Toronto's Children's Services division by calling 311 or going to their website at www.toronto.ca/children

The Daycare management believes that strict adherence to a first-come, first-served policy is the only fair and equitable process.

Please note that because the demand for Daycare spaces is generally greater than the number of spaces available, we maintain a waiting list for each birth year. There are separate applications and procedures for the Nursery School program and the Daycare programs.

If a family declines to accept a spot when offered, the child's application will be taken off the list and it will be up to the family to submit a new application.

From time to time the Executive Director/Supervisor may request the Board of Directors of Jackman Community Daycare to approve an exception to the policy for programming needs or unforeseen circumstances.
