High-speed milling technology found in the LO 410, prevents cut contents and produces a smooth, soft and feathered edge.

Other cutters, such as slicing or guillotine style cutters, can often leave a jagged and rough cut edge that may result in painful paper cuts or damaged contents. The LO 410 opens envelopes edge-to-edge for easy content removal.

The large easy to read 5.5" display allows for simple navigation to job functions and settings. In combination with an integrated ink jet printer, the LO 410 offers mail counting as it is processed. Alternatively you can choose to imprint the mail with time and date.

Cut Depth Adjustment Knob

- Use one of three "cut depth" settings to open thin to thick mail and flats
- Count envelopes without cutting using the "no cut" setting
- Open 3,500 envelopes before emptying the large capacity chip tray
