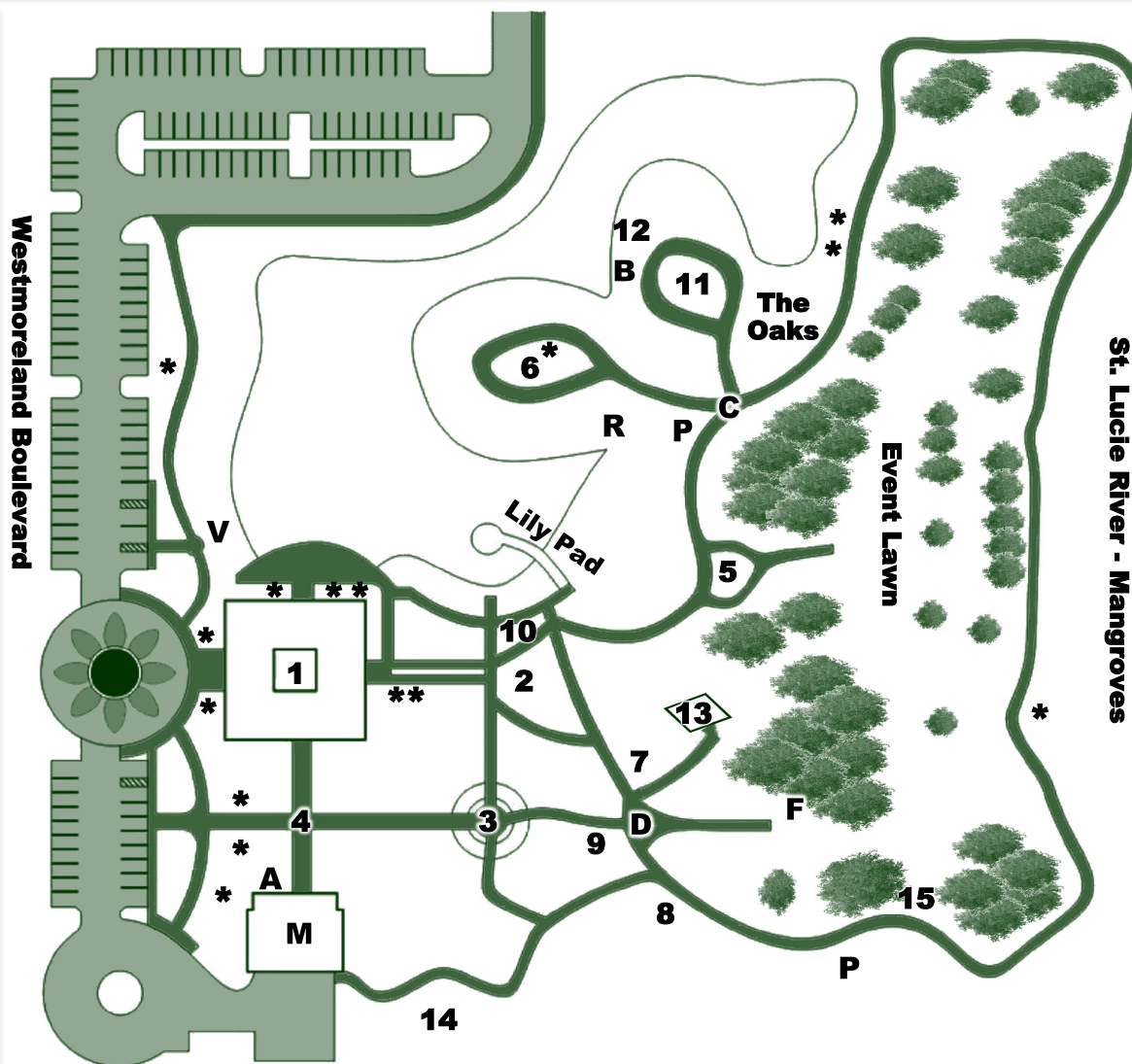

THE GARDENS

The Port St. Lucie Botanical Gardens held its public grand opening on March 6, 2010. The Gardens sit on +/- 20 acres of property on the west side of Westmoreland Boulevard, just south of Port St. Lucie Blvd., conveniently located within the city. The property was acquired through the joint efforts of the City of Port St. Lucie, St. Lucie County, and the Florida Trust for Public Lands.

The site boasts a lake with a fountain and catch and release fishing, convenient paths, beautiful gardens, a pavilion, a gift shop and an array of spaces both inside and out for weddings, meetings, receptions and a host of other events. There is an abundance of convenient on-site parking. The Gardens wetlands and mangroves sit on the banks of the beautiful, pristine North Fork of the St. Lucie River. This site is comprised of Scrub, Scrubby Flatwoods, Bay-Gall and Wet Flatwoods, with a mangrove fringe. The 12.87 acres south of The Gardens access road will be maintained as undisturbed Florida wetlands, subject only to the removal of exotics and maintenance of an eventual walking trail.

- Opened March 2010
- Size - 21 acres (minus wetlands & mangroves, just over 7.5 acres)
- Lake - 2+ acres, 12 feet deep
- Size of Pavilion - 4100 sq. ft. & can accommodate up to 375 regular seating, 125 table seating, or 100 table seating with a dance floor.
- Amphitheater - Seats 140-160 with additional standing on Pavilion Plaza
- Sidewalks - 6 feet wide. Length 0.91 miles
- Park Benches - 15 scattered throughout
- Picnic tables - 2 within The Gardens
- Cafe tables and chairs on the veranda
- Parking - 41 paved and 85 stabilized spaces for a total of 126
- The Gardens is ADA compliant.
