To maintain these standards and to continue to improve both on and off the field we have come up with some common sense standards that we all should strive to achieve.

Coaches, Captains and Executive

1. Always be an example (role model) of how a Brit-Lion should be.
2. Promote the club positively whenever possible.
3. Respect all referees, rugby officials and opponents.
4. Respect, Encourage, Support all players.
5. Promote safety, player well-being always comes first.
6. Always be available, to each other and the players. Good, open and honest communications are vital.

Players

1. Be proud to be a member of the club and its history.
2. Act responsibly before, during and after games. Do not act in any way that would reflect badly on the club.
3. Play within the spirit and the laws of the game. Rugby should be enjoyable, learn the laws if in doubt.
4. Respect referees, never abuse or question a referee's decision. Use the Captain on the field.
5. Support your team-mates, on the field and by watching the other games.
6. Respect all opponents, shake hands after each game, buy your opposite a drink.
7. Pay your club dues promptly.
8. Always wear club colors when playing, proper socks and shorts.
9. Respect the Club facilities; look after the playing fields and changing areas.
10. Play where selected and spare when required, respect the coaching staff.
11. When requested assist in Club duties, do bar duties, bbq help, pick up garbage.
12. When requested mentor another player in any grade of the Club.
13. Always be punctual for practice and games. If you will be late or are not available to play, let the Coach or Captain know in advance.
